

2. The officers equivalent to Joint Secretary to Government of India and above, who have not already applied for DFFT programme in response to circular dated 29.11.2016 are eligible to apply. There is no upper age limit for this course, however, the officer should be left with at least one year service at the time of commencement of the programme. Other conditions of the eligibility, as contained in circular dated 29.11.2016, shall be applicable. For officers on Central Staffing Scheme of DoPT, whose tenure ends during the currency of the training programme, shall be required to take prior approval of EO Division, DoPT.

3. The online application form is available in this Ministry's website at <http://persmin.nic.in/dfft>. The last date for application by applicants is **01.05.2017** and the last date for finalization of application by Nodal Officers is **10.05.2017**. A User Guide for facilitating to apply for training programmes is prepared and available at online application portal. At the time of registration on online application procedure, officers will also get an e-mail from the NIC system explaining about the application process.
