

IMPORTANT DEVELOPMENTS WITH REGARD TO DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL & TRAINING FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER, 2017

1. Valedictory session of Assistant Secretaries (IAS officers of 2015 batch) was held on 26th September, 2017. Eight (8) selected presentations on various themes of governance were made by Assistant Secretaries on this day. Addressing on this occasion, Hon'ble Prime Minister urged the officers to work towards creating the India of the dreams of those who made sacrifices for getting India Freedom from foreign rule, by 2022.
2. DOP&T undertook "Swachhata Hi Sewa" campaign during 15th September, 2017 to 2nd October, 2017 and carried out several activities such as cleanliness drive in association with New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC).
3. The policy for cadre allotment for the All India Services-IAS/IPS/IFoS was revised vide this Department's O.M. No. 13013/2/2016-AIS.I dated 05.09.2017 and the same has been published on this Department's website.
4. Cadre Review of IPS (AGMUT) done vide Notification dated 08.09.2017.
5. Appointment's Committee of the Cabinet (ACC) has approved appointments in **15** cases in various Schedule A & B Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs). Further, ACC has approved six (**06**) appointments of Chairpersons/Members in various Tribunals/ Statutory Bodies/ Authorities/ Commissions and nine (**09**) appointments of Chief Executives in Autonomous Bodies/Institutes.
6. Cabinet Secretary/ACC has approved four (**04**) premature repatriation proposals, two (**02**) proposals of Appointment of PS to Ministers, seven (**07**) proposals of appointment of PS to Ministers (lateral shift), One (**01**) proposal of Appointment of OSD to Ministers, three (**03**) extension proposals, two (**02**) proposals of curtailment of tenure and seven (**07**) appointments (Non-CSS) proposal. Further Two (**02**) officers have been appointed as CVO and Five (**05**) officers have been retained on offer under the Central Staffing Scheme.
7. This Department vide O.M. No. 36033/1/2013-Estt. (Res.) dated 13th September 2017 inter alia conveyed the decision of Central Government to raise the income limit from 6 lakh to 8 lakh per annum for determining the creamy layer amongst the Other Backward Classes.
8. Clarification has been issued vide this Department's O.M. No. 31011/8/2017-Estt.A-IV dated 19.09.2017 regarding travel entitlements of Government Servants for the purpose of LTC post 7th CPC.

9. In light of D/o Expenditure's OM No. 29/1/2017-E.II(B) dated 11.07.2017, DOP&T vide O.M. No. 2/12/2017-Estt.(Pay-II) dated 14.09.2017 has issued instructions regarding abolition of Headquarters Special Pay/ Special Allowance in respect of officers of the Organized Group 'A' services on their posting in their respective headquarters.
