**Subject: Appointment of Information Commissioners in the Central Information Commission.**

Under the Right to Information Act 2005, the Government of India has constituted the Central Information Commission which is located in New Delhi. The powers and functions of the Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission are as per the RTI Act, 2005.

2. It is proposed to appoint Information Commissioners in the Central Information Commission.

3. The Act provides that the Information Commissioner: -

- (i) shall be a person of eminence in public life with wide knowledge and experience in law, science and technology, social service, management, journalism, mass-media or administration and governance.
- (ii) shall not be a Member of Parliament or Member of the Legislature of any State or Union Territory, as the case may be, or hold any other office of profit or connected with any political party or carrying on any business or pursuing any profession. It is clarified that cessation/termination of holding of office of profit, pursuing any profession or carrying any business is a condition precedent to the appointment of a person as Information Commissioner.

4. Persons who have attained the age of 65 years shall not be eligible for appointment.

5. The salary, allowances and other terms and conditions of service of the Information Commissioners shall be as may be specified at the time of appointment of the selected candidate/s.

6. Persons fulfilling the criteria and interested for appointment to the post of Information Commissioner may send their particulars in the enclosed proforma, by post, to Under Secretary (RTI), Department of Personnel and Training, North Block, New Delhi or through e-mail to [usrti-dopt@nic.in](mailto:usrti-dopt@nic.in) so as to reach between 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2018 and 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2018. ## BJP may drop majority of MLAs in Raj, MP to cut anti-incumbency

### BJP youth wing to hold conclave in Hyd

New Delhi: BJP is set to finalise candidates for upcoming polls by November first week with a strong possibility of dropping majority of sitting MLAs in Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh to beat anti-incumbency, a trend the party has followed in deciding its nominees for Chhattisgarh.

Senior leaders are confident of retaining power in three states and gaining majority in Mizoram although they concede that it would be a tough fight in Rajasthan.

Party sources said the Central Election Committee (CEC), in the presence of PM Narendra Modi and party chief Amit Shah, will finalise most of the candidates on November 1-2 for which initial exercise of preparing a list of potential candidates has been completed. The party released the first list of 77 candidates Chhattisgarh

With BJP keen to gain ground in the southern states where the party has little presence, its youth wing - BJYM - is set to organise a three-day "mega summit" in poll-bound Telangana starting Friday, which will be addressed by party chief Amit Shah on the concluding day. Yuva Mahadiveshan will be inaugurated by home minister Rajan Singh on October 26 in Hyderabad.

### **Appointment of Chief Information Commissioners in the Central Information Commission:**

#### **Rule Position:**

1. As per section 12 (2) of the Right to Information Act, 2005, the Central Information Commission shall consist of the Chief Information Commissioner and such number of Central Information Commissioners, **not exceeding ten**, as may be deemed necessary. The tenure of the present incumbent Chief Information Commissioner is getting over on 24.11.2018.

2. Section 12 (3) of the Act stipulates that the Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission shall be appointed by the President on the recommendation of a Committee consisting of the following:-

- (i) the Prime Minister who shall be the Chairperson of the Committee;
- (ii) \*the Leader of the Opposition in the Lok Sabha; and
- (iii) a Union Cabinet Minister to be nominated by the Prime Minister.

\*where the Leader of Opposition in the House of the People has not been recognized as such, the Leader of the single largest group in opposition of the Government in the House of the People shall be deemed to be the Leader of Opposition.

3. As per Section 12(5) of the RTI Act, 2005, the Chief Information Commissioner shall be persons of eminence in public life with wide knowledge and experience in "**law, science and technology, social service, management, journalism, mass media or administration and governance.**"

4. Section 12(6) of the RTI Act, 2005 mandates that the Chief Information Commissioner shall not be a Member of Parliament or Member of the Legislature of any State or Union Territory, as the case may be, or hold any other office of profit or connected with any political party or carrying on any business or pursuing any profession.

5. Section 13(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 provides that the Chief Information Commissioner shall hold office for a term of five years from the date on which he enters upon his office and shall not be eligible for reappointment; Provided that no Chief Information Commissioner shall hold office as such after he has attained the age of sixty-five years.



## Process

6. As per past practice, the process of selection of Chief Information Commissioner involves following steps:-

- (i) Particulars of interested persons are invited through advertisements in newspapers and through DoPT's website.
- (ii) Particulars of applicants are tabulated by DoPT and sent to a Search Committee chaired by Cabinet Secretary.
- (iii) Names shortlisted are sent to the Committee constituted under Section 12(3) headed by the Hon'ble Prime Minister.
- (iv) Person recommended by the Committee constituted under Section 12(3) is appointed by the Hon'ble President.

7. The competent authority has approved the constitution of Search Committee for selection of Chief Information Commissioner with the following composition:-

(b) The competent authority has also nominated Shri Arun Jaitley, Union Cabinet Minister as member of the Committee to be constituted under Section 12(3) of RTI Act.

(c) An advertisement was posted on the DOPT's website on 23.10.2018 inviting particulars of the interested persons for the post of Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission. The last date of receipt of applications was 12.11.2018 (before 5:00 PM). An advertisement was also published in 4 leading newspapers- The Hindu' and 'Times of India'(in English); 'Dainik Bhaskar' and 'Hindustan' (in Hindi) and their editions throughout India by the Directorate of Advertising & Visual Publicity (DAVP).

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8. The applications received for the post of Chief Information Commissioner were been placed before the Search Committee. The Search Committee were recommend the names of suitable persons to the Committee headed by the Prime Minister for recommendation for appointment of Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission. The names recommended by the Search Committee will be placed before the Committee constituted under Section 12(3) of the RTI Act 2005 in he meeting.

9. The Agenda note is submitted for kind consideration of the Committee. The Committee may kindly recommend the name of candidate for the post of Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission.





### Agenda Note

#### **Appointment of Chief Information Commissioners in the Central Information Commission:**

##### **Rule Position:**

1. As per section 12 (2) of the Act, the Central Information Commission shall consist of the Chief Information Commissioner and such number of Central Information Commissioners, **not exceeding ten**, as may be deemed necessary. At present, the Central Information Commission has the Chief Information Commissioner and 6 (six) Information Commissioners.

2. Section 12 (3) of the Act stipulates that the Chief Information Commissioner and the Information Commissioners shall be appointed by the President on the recommendation of a Committee consisting of the following:-

- (i) the Prime Minister who shall be the Chairperson of the Committee;
- (ii) \*the Leader of the Opposition in the Lok Sabha; and
- (iii) a Union Cabinet Minister to be nominated by the Prime Minister.



The following Act of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 15th June, 2005, and is hereby published for general information:—

### THE RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005 No. 22 of 2005

*[15th June, 2005.]*

An Act to provide for setting out the practical regime of right to information for citizens to secure access to information under the control of public authorities, in order to promote transparency and accountability in the working of every public authority, the constitution of a Central Information Commission and State Information Commissions and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

WHEREAS the Constitution of India has established democratic Republic:

AND WHEREAS democracy requires an informed citizenry and transparency of information which are vital to its functioning and also to contain corruption and to hold Governments and their instrumentalities accountable to the governed;

AND WHEREAS revelation of information in actual practice is likely to conflict with other public interests including efficient operations of the Governments, optimum use of limited fiscal resources and the preservation of confidentiality of sensitive information;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to harmonise these conflicting interests while preserving the paramountcy of the democratic ideal:

NOW, THEREFORE, it is expedient to provide for furnishing certain information to citizens who desire to have it.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Fifty-sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

## CHAPTER I

### Preliminary

Short title,  
extent and  
commencement

1. (1) This Act may be called the Right to Information Act, 2005.

(2) It extends to the whole of India except the State of Jammu and Kashmir.

(3) The provisions of sub-section (1) of section 4, sub-sections (1) and (2) of section 5, sections 12, 13, 15, 16, 24, 27 and 28 shall come into force at once, and the remaining provisions of this Act shall come into force on the one hundred and twentieth day of its enactment.

Definitions.

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,—

(a) "appropriate Government" means in relation to a public authority which is established, constituted, owned, controlled or substantially financed by funds provided directly or indirectly—

(i) by the Central Government or the Union territory administration, the Central Government;

(ii) by the State Government, the State Government;

(b) "Central Information Commission" means the Central Information Commission constituted under sub-section (1) of section 12;

(c) "Central Public Information Officer" means the Central Public Information Officer designated under sub-section (1) and includes a Central Assistant Public Information Officer designated as such under sub-section (2) of section 5;

(d) "Chief Information Commissioner" and "Information Commissioner" mean the Chief Information Commissioner and Information Commissioner appointed under sub-section (3) of section 12;

(e) "competent authority" means—

(i) the Speaker in the case of the House of the People or the Legislative Assembly of a State or a Union territory having such Assembly and the Chairman in the case of the Council of States or Legislative Council of a State;

(ii) the Chief Justice of India in the case of the Supreme Court;

(iii) the Chief Justice of the High Court in the case of a High Court;

(iv) the President or the Governor, as the case may be, in the case of other authorities established or constituted by or under the Constitution;

(v) the administrator appointed under article 239 of the Constitution;

(f) "information" means any material in any form, including records, documents, memos, e-mails, opinions, advices, press releases, circulars, orders, logbooks, contracts, reports, papers, samples, models, data material held in any electronic form and information relating to any

private body which can be accessed by a public authority under any other law for the time being in force;

- (g) "prescribed" means prescribed by rules made under this Act by the appropriate Government or the competent authority, as the case maybe;
- (h) "public authority" means any authority or body or institution of self-government established or constituted—
  - (a) by or under the Constitution;
  - (b) by any other law made by Parliament;
  - (c) by any other law made by State Legislature;
  - (d) by notification issued or order made by the appropriate Government.

and includes any—

- (i) body owned, controlled or substantially financed;
- (ii) non-Government organisation substantially financed,

directly or indirectly by funds provided by the appropriate Government;

(i) "record" includes—

- (a) any document, manuscript and file;
- (b) any microfilm, microfiche and facsimile copy of a document;
- (c) any reproduction of image or images embodied in such microfilm (whether enlarged or not); and
- (d) any other material produced by a computer or any other device;

(j) "right to information" means the right to information accessible under this Act which is held by or under the control of any public authority and includes the right to—

- (i) inspection of work, documents, records;
- (ii) taking notes, extracts or certified copies of documents or records;
- (iii) taking certified samples of material;
- (iv) obtaining information in the form of diskettes, floppies, tapes, video cassettes or in any other electronic mode or through print outs where such information is stored in a computer or in any other device;

(k) "State Information Commission" means the State Information Commission constituted under sub-section (1) of section 15;

(l) "State Chief Information Commissioner" and "State Information Commissioner" mean the State Chief Information Commissioner and the State Information Commissioner appointed under sub-section (3) of section 15;

(m) "State Public Information Officer" means the State Public Information Officer designated under sub-section (1) and includes a State Assistant Public Information Officer designated as such under sub-section (2) of section 5;

(n) "third party" means a person other than the citizen making a request for information and includes a public authority.

## CHAPTER II

**Right to information and obligations of public authorities**

3. Subject to the provisions of this Act, all citizens shall have the right to information.

Right to  
information

4. (1) Every public authority shall—

- a) maintain all its records duly catalogued and indexed in a manner and the form which facilitates the right to information under this Act and ensure that all records that are appropriate to be computerised are, within a reasonable time and subject to availability of resources, computerised and connected through a network all over the country on different systems so that access to such records is facilitated;
- b) publish within one hundred and twenty days from the enactment of this Act—
  - (i) the particulars of its organisation, functions and duties;
  - (ii) the powers and duties of its officers and employees;
  - (iii) the procedure followed in the decision making process, including channels of supervision and accountability;
  - (iv) the norms set by it for the discharge of its functions;
  - (v) the rules, regulations, instructions, manuals and records, held by it or under its control or used by its employees for discharging its functions;
  - (vi) a statement of the categories of documents that are held by it or under its control;
  - (vii) the particulars of any arrangement that exists for consultation with, or representation by, the members of the public in relation to the formulation of its policy or implementation thereof;
  - (viii) a statement of the boards, councils, committees and other bodies consisting of two or more persons constituted as its part or for the purpose of its advice, and as to whether meetings of those boards, councils, committees and other bodies are open to the public, or the minutes of such meetings are accessible for public;
  - (ix) a directory of its officers and employees;
  - (x) the monthly remuneration received by each of its officers and employees, including the system of compensation as provided in its regulations;
  - (xi) the budget allocated to each of its agency, indicating the particulars of all plans, proposed expenditures and reports on disbursements made;
  - (xii) the manner of execution of subsidy programmes, including the amounts allocated and the details of beneficiaries of such programmes;
  - (xiii) particulars of recipients of concessions, permits or authorisations granted by it;
  - (xiv) details in respect of the information, available to or held by it, reduced in an electronic form;
  - (xv) the particulars of facilities available to citizens for obtaining information, including the working hours of a library or reading room, if maintained for public use;
  - (xvi) the names, designations and other particulars of the Public Information Officers;
  - (xvii) such other information as may be prescribed; and thereafter update these publications every year;
- c) publish all relevant facts while formulating important policies or announcing the decisions which affect public;
- d) provide reasons for its administrative or quasi-judicial decisions to affected persons.





**Subject: Appointment of Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission.**

Under the Right to Information Act 2005, the Government of India has constituted the Central Information Commission, which is located in New Delhi. The powers and functions of the Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission are as per the RTI Act, 2005.

2. It is proposed to appoint the Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission, to succeed the present incumbent on completion of the tenure likely on 24.11.2018.


3. The Act provides that the Chief Information Commissioner -

- (i) shall be a person of eminence in public life with wide knowledge and experience in law, science and technology, social service, management, journalism, mass-media or administration and governance.
- (ii) shall not be a Member of Parliament or Member of the Legislature of any State or Union Territory, as the case may be, or hold any other office of profit or connected with any political party or carrying on any business or pursuing any profession. It is clarified that cessation/termination of holding of office of profit, pursuing any profession or carrying any business is a condition precedent to the appointment of a person as Chief Information Commissioner.

4. Persons who have attained the age of 65 years shall not be eligible for appointment.

5. The salary, allowances and other terms and conditions of service of the Chief Information Commissioner shall be as may be specified at the time of appointment of the selected candidate.

6. Persons fulfilling the criteria and interested for appointment to the post of Chief Information Commissioner may send their particulars in the enclosed proforma, by post, to Under Secretary (IR), Room No. 215 A/III, Department of Personnel and Training, North Block, New Delhi or through e-mail to [usir-dopt@nic.in](mailto:usir-dopt@nic.in) so as to reach before 5:00 PM on 12<sup>th</sup> November, 2018. Persons serving under the State/Central Government or any other Organization, should send their particulars through proper channel (administrative Ministry/Department of State-UT/ Central Government or the Controlling Office respectively).

Minutes of the Meeting of the Search Committee held on 24.11.2018 for shortlisting candidates for appointment as Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission

**Present:**



## **Agenda Note I**

**Agenda note for consideration of the Committee constituted under the Chairmanship of the Prime Minister of India under Section 12(3) of the Right to Information Act 2005 for recommending the name to the President of India for appointment to the post of Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission**

### **Rule Position:**

1. As per section 12(2) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereafter, the RTI Act), the Central Information Commission shall consist of **the Chief Information Commissioner** and such number of Central Information Commissioners, not exceeding ten, as may be deemed necessary. The tenure of the previous incumbent Chief Information Commissioner elapsed on 24.11.2018.

2. Section 12 (3) of the Act stipulates that the Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission shall be appointed by the President on the recommendation of a Committee consisting of the following:-

- (i) the Prime Minister who shall be the Chairperson of the Committee;
- (ii) \*the Leader of the Opposition in the Lok Sabha; and
- (iii) a Union Cabinet Minister to be nominated by the Prime Minister.

\*where the Leader of Opposition in the House of the People has not been recognized as such, the Leader of the single largest group in opposition of the Government in the House of the People shall be deemed to be the Leader of Opposition.

3. As per Section 12(5) of the RTI Act, 2005, the Chief Information Commissioner shall be person of eminence in public life with wide knowledge and experience in "**law, science and technology, social service, management, journalism, mass media or administration and governance.**"

4. Section 12(6) of the RTI Act, 2005 mandates that the Chief Information Commissioner shall not be a Member of Parliament or Member of the Legislature of any State or Union Territory, as the case may be, or hold any other office of profit or connected with any political party or carrying on any business or pursuing any profession.

### **Process of Selection & Steps taken in the current process**

5. As per practice, the process of selection of Chief Information Commissioner involves following steps –

- (i) Particulars of interested persons are invited through advertisements in newspapers and through the website of the Department of Personnel & Training ( hereafter, DoPT ) ;
- (ii) Particulars of applicants are tabulated by DoPT and sent to a Search Committee chaired by Cabinet Secretary ;
- (iii) Names shortlisted are sent to the Committee constituted under Section 12(3) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 headed by the Prime Minister of India ;

- (iv) Person recommended by the Committee is appointed by the Hon'ble President.

6. An advertisement was accordingly posted on the DOPT's website on 23.10.2018 inviting particulars of the interested persons for the post of Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission. The last date of receipt of applications was 12.11.2018 (before 5:00 PM). An advertisement was also published in 4 leading newspapers – 'The Hindu' and 'Times of India' (in English); 'Dainik Bhaskar' and 'Hindustan' (in Hindi) and their editions throughout India. In response, 64 applications were received for the post of Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission by the last date, i.e. 12.11.2018.

7. The competent authority has approved the constitution of Search Committee for selection of Chief Information Commissioner with the following composition:-

i.	Cabinet Secretary	Chairman
ii.	Additional Principal Secretary to PM	Member
iii.	Secretary (Personnel)	Member
iv.	Secretary (I&B)	Member
v.	Secretary (Expenditure)	Member
vi.	Dr. Manoj Panda (Director), Institute of Economic Growth, Delhi University	Member

The particulars of all applicants for the post of Chief Information Commissioner were tabulated by DoPT and placed before the Search Committee (list of applications at pages 06-21). The Search Committee recommendations will be placed before the Committee constituted U/s 12(3) of the Right to Information Act during the meeting.

### **Supreme Court Directions in Related Court Case**


8. In Anjali Bharadwaj & Ors Vs. Union of India & Ors in Writ Petition No.436 of 2018, the Hon'ble Supreme Court has vide its order dated 03.12.2018 directed inter alia Union of India to file status report indicating the steps which have been taken for filling up of the vacant posts and also the manner in which these posts are sought to be filled. The case is listed next on 13.12.2018.

9. A copy of the Right to Information Act 2005 is annexed for information.

3. The Committee was apprised of the directions dated 03.12.2018 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in a Writ Petition No. 436/2018 filed by Anjali Bhardwaj & Ors Vs. Union of India and Ors in which the Hon'ble Supreme Court has directed the Union of India to file status report indicating the steps which have been taken for filling up of the vacant posts and also the manner in which these posts are sought to be filled.

**Shri Sudhir Bhargava IAS (Retd.) (RJ:79)**







5. It is submitted that the advertisement was also uploaded on DoPT's website for inviting applications for filling up of the posts of Information Commissioners in the Central Information Commission (CIC). Presently, there are four vacant posts of

Information Commissioners in the Central Information Commissioners that are under the purview of the aforesaid advertisement for now. Suitable decision, in respect of the vacancies likely to arise in the future in the CIC, would be taken subsequently according to the requirement/ exigencies at the time. True typed copy of the notification published on the DOPT website inviting persons interested for the post of Information Commissioners to send their particulars is annexed herewith as **Annexure – R2.**

6. It is humbly submitted that the appointment of Information Commissioners in CIC is a comprehensive process that is undertaken at the highest level in the Government. As per section 12(3) of the Right to Information Act 2005, the Chief Information Commissioners and Information Commissioners shall be appointed by the President on the recommendation of the Selection Committee consisting of:-
- (i) The Prime Minister, who shall be the Chairperson of the Committee;
  - (ii) The Leader of the Opposition in the Lok Sabha; and
  - (iii) A Union Cabinet Minister to be nominated by the Prime Minister.

Where the Leader of Opposition in the House of the People has not been recognised as such, the Leader of the single largest

group in opposition of the Government in the House of the People shall be deemed to be the Leader of the Opposition.

7. In practice the process of selection of Information Commissioners involves following steps:-

- i) Particulars of the interested persons are invited through advertisements in newspapers and on DoPT's website. It is submitted, that this has already been carried out for the ongoing process and the closing date for the receipt of application is 31.08.2018.
- ii) Particulars of the applications are to be tabulated and sent to the Search Committee that shall be constituted by the Hon'ble Prime Minister and chaired by the Cabinet Secretary. It is further submitted, that the composition of the Search Committee for the ongoing process has been approved by the Hon'ble Prime Minister meanwhile.
- iii) Names shortlisted by the Search Committee are to be sent to the Selection Committee constituted under 12(3) of the RTI Act and headed by the Hon'ble Prime Minister. It is submitted that the composition of the Selection Committee has been duly finalized for the process currently underway.

iv) Persons recommended by the Selection Committee headed by Hon'ble Prime Minister are to be appointed by the Hon'ble President.

8. It is further submitted for kind appreciation that in the RTI Act, a specific time frame has not been stipulated for submission of recommendations by the Selection Committee. However, in practice an adequate time is taken by the Committee for careful consideration of the applications received. As may be kindly appreciated, this would depend inter-alia on the number of applications received and also the availability of the Hon'ble Chairperson and other Members of these Committees.
9. It is submitted that in light of the above that at this stage, when the application process is still on and it is not known as to how many applications would be received, the precise time schedule within which the posts are to be filled up is difficult to be indicated.
10. The Hon'ble court vide order 27.07.2018 also directed that the affidavit shall respond to the said Prayer 'F' of the Writ Petition. Reply to each Clause of Prayer "F" of the Writ Petition are submitted here under:-

a) In reply to Prayer F (a) of the Writ Petition it is submitted that Advertisement for inviting applications for the posts of Information Commissioners have been published in leading newspapers on 27.7.2018 (two each English and Hindi) and also uploaded on DoPT's website. True copy of the advertisement is provided at **Annexure- R1 as already disclosed above.**

b) In reply to Prayer F(b) of the Writ Petition it is submitted that the eligibility criterion for appointment as Information Commissioner have been prescribed in the RTI Act itself vide Section 12(5). Those have accordingly been incorporated in the aforementioned advertisement (**Annexure-R1 as aforementioned**). This has also been uploaded on the DoPT's website.

c) In reply to Prayer F(c) of the Writ Petition it is submitted that Short listing of the candidates has not yet been done. The scrutiny of the applications/candidates would be done by the designated Search committee after the closing date for receipt of applications i.e. 31.08.2018. It is upto the approved Search Committee to devise modalities for shortlisting of the candidates out of the applications received. Paragraph 3 of the

notification published on the DOPT website inviting persons interested for the post of Information Commissioners (**Annexure – R2** as aforementioned) quotes the RTI Act, 2005 with respect to the criteria/qualifications for the person(s) who is/are to be appointed as an Information Commissioner.

d) In reply to Prayer F(d) of the Writ Petition it is submitted that The approved composition of the Search Committee is as follows:-

- (i) Cabinet Secretary - Chairman
- (ii) Additional Principal Secretary to PM - Member
- (iii) Secretary (Personnel) - Member
- (iv) Secretary (I&B) - Member
- (v) Secretary (Expenditure) - Member
- (vi) One outside expert.

The Search Committee would shortlist the eligible candidates for consideration of the Selection Committee headed by the Hon'ble Prime Minister. It is respectfully submitted however that it would not be conducive to publish such details in the manner sought. No such practice is followed in any other equivalent high level appointments of Government.



e) In reply of Prayer F(e) of the Writ Petition it is submitted that it has not been a practice to disclose the list of short-listed candidates prior to the completion of the selection process or to seek adverse information on the short-listed candidates from the public. The Search and Selection Committees evolve their own method of obtaining relevant information in respect of various candidates. However, it would not be conducive to publish such details in the manner sought. No such practice is followed in any other equivalent high level appointments of Government.

f) The Hon'ble Court also observed in the order dated 27.07.2018 that Government of India had issued similar advertisement in the year 2016, however, no appointments have been made pursuant thereto. It is submitted that the Government of India had issued advertisement dated 02.09.2016 in the leading newspapers (two each English and Hindi) and also uploaded on the DoPT's website inviting applications for filling up of posts of Information Commissioners. A process for amendment of the Right to Information Act, 2005 was also initiated to incorporate express / specific enabling provisions for determining the term of 'office', salaries and allowances payable to and other terms and conditions of service of the Chief Information

Commissioner and the Information Commissioners of the Central Information Commission and Chief State Information Commissioners and State Information Commissioners. The aforesaid selection process was not pursued pending the outcome of the process for amendment of the Act.



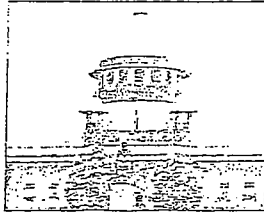

## Govt asks SC to revisit choice of two lawyers as HC judges

New Delhi: The government has asked the Supreme Court collegium to reconsider its recommendation to appoint two lawyers as high court judges but did not cite any reason for its move, a senior government functionary said.

The SC collegium had in 2015 recommended names of Harnareesh Singh Gill and Mohammed Nizamuddin for appointment as judges of the Punjab and Haryana high court and the Calcutta high court respectively.

Recently too, the top court collegium's recommendation for the appointments of two lawyers, one of them a former top court judge's son, as judges of the Allahabad high court was returned for the second time by the government citing complaints against them.

The two lawyers are Mohammad Mansoor and Basharat Ali Khan. Mansoor is the son of former Supreme Court judge late Saghir Ahmed.

\* Delhi: In a landmark decision in the field of trademarks, the Supreme Court on Thursday said that it was infringement of law if two distinctly different products are marketed by two different companies with "deceptively similar" trademarks. A decade-old trademark infringement case between Karaka Cooperative Milk Producers Association, which has been marketing milk and milk products under the trademark 'andhini' since 1985, and a shop adopting the name 'andhini' for its restaurant and food products business in 9, continued through the Registrar of Trademarks, Intellectual Property Appellate and Karnataka High Court. With the board and the restraining the restaurant from using the 'Andhini' trademark, the battle shifted to the SC in 2015.

UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

Union of India has filed affidavit dated 12.12.2018 mentioning the status of the appointments to the post of Chief Information Commissioner as well as Information Commissioners.

It is stated by learned Additional Solicitor General that insofar as the post of Chief Information Commissioner is concerned, pursuant to the advertisement, 64 applications were received. It is further informed that insofar as the posts of Information Commissioners are concerned, 4 posts are advertised and 280 applications were received. It is mentioned that advertisement was uploaded on the Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT) website.

Learned Additional Solicitor General also submits that the Selection Committee, as per Section 12 of the Right to Information Act, 2005, held a meeting on 11.12.2018 on which date the recommendation in respect of appointment of Chief Information Commissioner has been finalised and it is expected that the person shall be appointed soon. Insofar as post of Information Commissioners are concerned, having regard to a large number of applications, process could not be completed on that day. It is further stated at the Bar that this shall also be accomplished soon.

We are informed that three more posts of Information

Commissioners are lying vacant. It would be appropriate to initiate the process of filling up these posts as well by issuing an advertisement at the earliest.

Mr. Prashant Bhushan, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners, submits that Paragraph 5 of the advertisement for the post of Chief Information Commissioner reads as under:

"The salary, allowances and other terms and conditions of service of the Chief Information Commissioner shall be as may be specified at the time of appointment of the selected candidate."

His submission is that the RTI Act mentions salary, allowances and other terms of the Chief Information Commissioner to be appointed and the stipulation could not have been in vague terms as stated there. This is the aspect that shall be considered on the next date of hearing.

He further submits that similar clause is put in the advertisement pertaining to Information Commissioners. This aspect also will be considered on the next date of hearing.

However, we may take on record the statement of learned Additional Solicitor General that the RTI Act itself mentions the terms and conditions on which appointments of Chief Information Commissioner and Information Commissioners in the Central Information Commission are to be made.

The respondents shall put on the website the names of the Search Committee, the names of the candidates who have been shortlisted as well as the criteria which is followed for selection. We may again record the statement of learned Additional Solicitor General that the selection criteria is prescribed in the

RTI Act itself which is being followed. Still, that can be put on the website.

STATE OF KARNATAKA:

In the affidavit filed on behalf of the State of Karnataka it is mentioned that there is only one vacancy of the State Information Commissioner ("SIO") which has been advertised. However, in the meantime, the High Court of Karnataka has stayed the appointment process.

STATE OF MAHARASHTRA:

In the affidavit filed on behalf of the State of Maharashtra it is mentioned that the post of State Chief Information Commissioner ("SCIC") has already been filled. It is also stated that steps have been taken for filling up the post of one State Information Commissioner ("SIC") and that would happen soon. It is further stated that there are two post of SIC which have been fallen vacant now and in respect of these two posts process for filling up the posts through advertisement will be initiated positively within four weeks.

They shall also disclose on the website the particulars on the same lines as directed in the case of Union of India.

STATE OF WEST BENGAL:

Learned counsel appearing for the State of West Bengal submits that SCIC has already been appointed. She further states that one SIC is already in place and one more SIC has been appointed. In

this way, as of now, one SCIC and two SICs are holding the office. As per the RTI Act up to ten SICs can be appointed. We are not sure as to whether the entire work can be dealt with by only one SCIC and two SICs.

The State of West Bengal shall file an affidavit stating the requirement of SICs. The information shall also be provided in respect of the applications under the RTI Act which are being filed, the applications which are pending as well as the appeals which are pending before the SICs and for how long they are pending. The pendency shall also be disclosed. An affidavit in this behalf shall be filed within two weeks.

STATE OF ANDHRA PRADESH:

Learned counsel for the State of Andhra Pradesh has handed over affidavit dated 12.12.2018. As per this affidavit, three persons are appointed as SIC. It is also stated that though the post of SCIC was also advertised but nobody could be appointed and it is not decided to issue fresh advertisement in this behalf. Insofar as SCIC is concerned, he has mentioned that advertisement was issued on 24.08.2018 and the last date for receiving the applications was extended up to 10.10.2018. Thirty one applications have been received and it is proposed to hold Selection Committee's meeting soon. We expect that such meeting shall take place as soon as possible and within one month the SCIC shall also be appointed.

It is also stated that, in the meantime, Mr. M. Ravi Kumar, who is working as SIC, is placed as In-charge for the post of SCIC so that the Commission may function.

An affidavit shall also be filed on the same lines as directed in the case of State of West Bengal before the next date of listing. They shall also disclose on the website the particulars on the same lines as directed in the case of Union of India.

STATE OF TELANGANA:

Insofar as State of Telangana is concerned, affidavit has not been filed in compliance with the directions given by this Court on the last date of hearing. Learned counsel states that it was because of the reason that there were elections of the Legislative Assembly which concluded and results came only on 11.12.2018. He, therefore, seeks, and is granted, two weeks' time to file an affidavit.

In the affidavit to be filed not only it would be indicated as to how many SICs are functioning, the affidavit shall also disclose the steps which are taken to fill up the posts and how many posts are required to be filled. In case the State of Telangana has taken a decision not to fill ten posts of SIO, justification thereof shall be provided in the form of an affidavit by disclosing the information in the same manner in which it has been directed in respect of State of West Bengal.

STATE OF ODISHA:

As per the earlier affidavit filed on behalf of the State of Odisha, the State has decided to function the Information Commission with one SCIC and three SIC. It is stated that SCIC and two SICs are already working and there is one post of SIC for which



advertisement shall be issued very shortly.

Mr. Prashant Bhushan, learned counsel, submits that there are huge arrears before the Information Commission in the State of Odisha and there is no justification to have only three Information Commissioners.

The State of Odisha shall also file an affidavit on the same lines as directed in the case of State of West Bengal before the next date of listing. They shall also disclose on the website the particulars of selection etc. on the same lines as directed in the case of Union of India.

STATE OF GUJARAT:

Learned counsel for the State of Gujarat states that she has received information from the State only two days ago and she shall be filing the affidavit within one week. However, she orally informs that as per the information received, in the State of Gujarat, the Information Commission consists of one SCIC and four SIC. She further submits that the SCIC and one SIC are functioning. Three vacancies for the post of SIC have already been advertised and the process is on. According to her, applications have been received and are pending before the Selection Committee.

We expect the Selection Committee to complete the process at the earliest, preferably before the next date of hearing.

They shall also disclose on the website the particulars of selection etc. on the same lines as directed in the case of Union of India.

STATE OF KERALA:

Learned counsel for the State of Kerala states that one SCIC and four SIC are functioning. Five posts of SICs could not be filled because of pendency of some writ petition(s) in the Kerala High Court.






