

The Government of India has constituted a body known as the Central Information Commission to exercise the powers conferred on and to perform the functions assigned to it under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (the Act). It is located in Delhi. The Commission shall have the Chief Information Commissioner and up to ten Information Commissioners. The present composition of the Central Information Commission can be seen at <u>www.cic.gov.in</u>. The powers and functions of an Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission are as per chapter V of the Right to Information Act, 2005.

2. It is proposed to appoint more Information Commissioners in the Commission. The Right to Information Act provides that the Information Commissioners shall be persons of eminence in public life with wide knowledge and experience in law, science and technology, social service, management, journalism, mass-media or administration and governance. The Information Commissioner shall not be a Member of Parliament or Member of the Legislature of any State or Union Territory, as the case may be or hold any other office of profit or connected with any political party or carrying on any business or pursuing any profession.

3. An Information Commissioner shall hold office for a term of five years from the date on which he enters upon his office or till he attains the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier. The salary and allowances payable to an Information Commissioner shall be the same as that of an Election Commissioner subject to adjustment of the pensionary/retirement benefits availed by him, if any, in accordance with the provisions of the Act.

4. Persons fulfilling the criteria for appointment as Information Commissioner and interested for appointment to the post may send their particulars in the enclosed proforma by post to Under Secretary (IR), Department of Personnel and Training, North Block, New Delhi or through e-mail to <u>usrti-dopt@nic.in</u> by November 18, 2011. 4. An Information Commissioner shall hold office for a term of five years from the date on which he enters upon his office or till he attains the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier. The salary and allowances payable to an Information Commissioner shall be the same as that of an Election Commissioner, subject to adjustment of the pensionary/retirement benefits availed by him, if any, in accordance with the provisions of the Act.

5. in the decision-making process, which in turn would serve the larger public purpose. It shall also ensure greater and more effective access to information, which would result in making the invocation of right to information more objective and meaningful.

106. For the elaborate discussion and reasons afore-recorded, we pass the following order and directions:

1. The writ petition is partly allowed.

2. The provisions of Sections 12(5) and 15(5) of the Act of 2005 are held to be constitutionally valid, but with the rider that, to give it a meaningful and purposive interpretation, it is necessary for the Court to 'read into' these provisions some aspects without which these provisions are bound to offend the doctrine of equality. Thus, we hold and declare that the expression 'knowledge and experience' appearing in these provisions would mean and include a basic degree in the respective field and the experience gained thereafter. Further, without any peradventure and veritably, we state that appointments of legally qualified, judicially trained and experienced persons would certainly manifest in more effective serving of the ends of justice as well as ensuring better administration of justice by the Commission. It would render

the adjudicatory process which involves critical legal questions and nuances of law, more adherent to justice and shall enhance the public confidence in the working of the Commission. This is the obvious interpretation of the language of these provisions and, in fact, is the essence thereof.

- 3. As opposed to declaring the provisions of Section 12(6) and 15(6) unconstitutional, we would prefer to read these provisions as having effect 'post-appointment'. In other words, cessation/termination of holding of office of profit, pursuing any profession or carrying any business is a condition precedent to the appointment of a person as Chief Information Commissioner or Information Commissioner at the Centre or State levels.
- 4. There is an absolute necessity for the legislature to reword or amend the provisions of Section 12(5), 12(6) and 15(5), 15(6) of the Act. We observe and hope that these provisions would be amended at the earliest by the legislature to avoid any ambiguity or impracticability and to make it in consonance with the constitutional mandates.

- 5. We also direct that the Central Government and/or the competent authority shall frame all practice and procedure related rules to make working of the Information Commissions effective and in consonance with the basic rule of law. Such rules should be framed with particular reference to Section 27 and 28 of the Act within a period of six months from today.
- 6. We are of the considered view that it is an unquestionable proposition of law that the Commission is a 'judicial tribunal' performing functions of 'judicial' as well as 'quasi-judicial' nature and having the trappings of a Court. It is an important cog and is part of the court attached system of administration of justice, unlike a ministerial tribunal which is more influenced and controlled and performs functions akin to the machinery of administration.
- 7. It will be just, fair and proper that the first appellate authority (i.e. the senior officers to be nominated in terms of Section 5 of the Act of 2005) preferably should be the persons possessing a degree in law or having adequate knowledge and experience in the field of law.
- 8. The Information Commissions at the respective levels shall henceforth work in Benches of two members each. One of

them being a 'judicial member', while the other an 'expert member'. The judicial member should be a person possessing a degree in law, having a judicially trained mind and experience in performing judicial functions. A law officer or a lawyer may also be eligible provided he is a person who has practiced law at least for a period of twenty years as on the date of the advertisement. Such lawyer should also have experience in social work. We are of the considered view that the competent authority should prefer a person who is or has been a Judge of the High Court for appointment as Information Chief Information Commissioner at the Commissioners. Centre or State level shall only be a person who is or has been a Chief Justice of the High Court or a Judge of the Supreme Court of India.

- 9. The appointment of the judicial members to any of these posts shall be made 'in consultation' with the Chief Justice of India and Chief Justices of the High Courts of the respective States, as the case may be.
- 10. The appointment of the Information Commissioners at both levels should be made from amongst the persons empanelled by the DoPT in the case of Centre and the concerned Ministry

in the case of a State. The panel has to be prepared upon due advertisement and on a rational basis as afore-recorded.

- 11. The panel so prepared by the DoPT or the concerned Ministry ought to be placed before the High-powered Committee in terms of Section 12(3), for final recommendation to the President of India. Needless to repeat that the High Powered Committee at the Centre and the State levels is expected to adopt a fair and transparent method of recommending the names for appointment to the competent authority.
- 12. The selection process should be commenced at least three months prior to the occurrence of vacancy.
- 13. This judgment shall have effect only prospectively.
- 14. Under the scheme of the Act of 2005, it is clear that the orders of the Commissions are subject to judicial review before the High Court and then before the Supreme Court of India. In terms of Article 141 of the Constitution, the judgments of the Supreme Court are law of the land and are binding on all courts and tribunals. Thus, it is abundantly clear that the Information Commission is bound by the law of precedence, i.e., judgments of the High Court and the Supreme Court of

India. In order to maintain judicial discipline and consistency in the functioning of the Commission, we direct that the Commission shall give appropriate attention to the doctrine of precedence and shall not overlook the judgments of the courts dealing with the subject and principles applicable, in a given case.

It is not only the higher court's judgments that are binding precedents for the Information Commission, but even those of the larger Benches of the Commission should be given due acceptance and enforcement by the smaller Benches of the Commission. The rule of precedence is equally applicable to intra appeals or references in the hierarchy of the Commission.

107. The writ petition is partly allowed with the above directions, however, without any order as to costs.

ORDER

I.A.NO. 6 in R.P.(C) No. 2309 of 2012

This is an application for stay of the operation of the judgment dated 13th September, 2012 passed in Writ Petition (C) No. 210 of 2012 titled Namit Sharma Vs. Union of India reported as 2013 (1) SCC 745 during the pendency of the Review Petition (C) No. 2309 of 2012 titled Union of India Vs. Namit Sharma.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties and we are not inclined to stay the operation of the entire judgment in Namit Sharma Vs. Union of India but we direct that the following directions in subparas 108.8 and 108.9 quoted here-in-below shall remain stayed during the pendency of the Review Petition (C) No. 2309 of 2012.

> 108.8 The Information Commissions at the respective levels shall henceforth work in Benches of two members each. One of them being a 'judicial member', while the other an 'expert member'. The judicial member should be a person possessing a degree in law, having a judicially trained mind and experience in performing judicial functions. A law officer or a lawyer may also be eligible provided he is a person who has practiced law at least for a period of twenty years as on the date of the advertisement. Such lawyer should also have experience in social work. We are of the considered view that the competent authority should prefer a person who is or has been a Judge of the High Court for appointment as Information Commissioners. Chief Information Commissioner at the Centre or State level shall only be a person who is or has been a Chief Justice of the High Court or a Judge of the Supreme Court of India.

> 108.9 The appointment of the judicial members to any of these posts shall be made 'in consultation' with the Chief Justice of India and Chief Justices of the High Courts of the respective States, as the case may be".

We further direct that wherever Chief Information Commissioner is of the opinion that intricate questions of law will have to be decided in a matter coming before the Information Commissioners, he will ensure that the matter is heard by a Bench of which at least one member has knowledge and experience in the field of Law.

We make it clear that subject to orders that may be finally passed after hearing the Review Petitions, the competent authority will continue to fill up the vacant posts of Information Commissioners in accordance with the Act and in accordance with the judgment in W.P.(C) No. 210 of 2012 except sub-paras 108.8 and 108.9 which we have stayed. This is to ensure that functioning of the Information Commissioners in accordance with the Act and the Judgment is not affected during the pendency of the Review Petitions.

We further make it clear that the Chief Commissioners already functioning will continue to function until the disposal of the Review Petitions.

I.A.No. 6 is ordered accordingly.

2. MOS(PP) has desired that the current system of appointment of CIC/ICs should be examined in the light of the judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter of appointment of Shri P.J.Thomas and flaws, if any be identified. It may be noted that the matter about change of method of selection of CIC/ICs has been under discussion in the Department for quite some time. Civil society functionaries also made request to the then MOS(PP) and the then Secretary(P) in February 2010 to make selection method of CIC/ICs more transparent.

3. Based on the discussions in the Department, draft proposal prescribing methodology for selection of CIC/ICs was prepared and submitted for consideration in July 2010 (Flag 'X'). The same proposal was submitted for directions again on a separate file in August, 2010. Relevant papers in the matter may be scen at Flag 'B'. On both the occasions, the files were submitted by then Secretary (P) for direction of MOS(PP). These files were returned by the office of the then MOS(PP) after he demitted office in November 2010. Thereafter, the same proposal was submitted for consideration of current MOS(PP) (page-13/n). MOS(PP) directed that the procedure in existence for long time for appointment of CIC/ICs may be followed (P.17/ante). Thereafter. Secretary(P) desired information about steps adopted during previous selections. The position in this regard was submitted vide note at pp.19-20/ante. Secretary(P) on page-20/n directed that the scrutiny of the names should be done in the Department.

4. The MOS(PP) has now desired that the methodology should be reviewed, particularly in the light of the guidelines laid down by the Supreme Court for selection of statutory functionaries like the CVC.

5. The judgement of the Supreme Court referred to above may be seen at **Flag 'C'.** It, though, pertains to the specific case of appointment of P.J.Thomas as CVC, it has relevance for the sclection of other statutory functionaries like CIC. The relevant part of the judgement appears to say that

- a) in case of selection of such high level functionaries, it is not only essential that the eligibility criteria be met but the decision making process for finalizing the recommendation should be "informed one" and should not be arbitrary.
- b) It further provides that a distinction need to be made between judicial review of such a recommendation and merit review. While courts may not examine the merit of the individual candidate who has been recommended, etc., courts are fully empowered to examine whether the procedure adopted for arriving at that recommendation/ selection was just, fair and reasonable.

- dissent with the opinion of the majority, then reasons be given for such dissent and the committee should give reasons as to why this dissent did not find favour while arriving at the final decision.
- d) Towards the end of the judgement, the Hon'ble Court has laid down the process which is specific to the selection of CVC. However, some of the steps that are relevant in the case of other statutory functionaries like CIC/ICs, such as preparation of panel of names at the level of the Department should be done after carefully defining the zone of consideration and after recording reasons for recommending a person or not recommending a person within that zone to the high powered committee;
- e) The selection committee should adopt a fair and transparent process of consideration of eminent persons while arriving at a decision.

6. In line with the direction of the MOS(PP) the current methodology of selection of CIC/ICs has been examined in the light of the above observation of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

7. The details of the method adopted for selection on previous occasions are given on page 19-20/n. It is noted that on all these occasions, there was no attempt on the part of the Department to obtain names of persons who could have been eligible in a transparent manner and to process these while submitting the proposal to the high powered committee for its consideration. On/occasion only one name for the consideration of the high powered committee was submitted which was selected without giving any reasons why no other names were considered fit for consideration. Thus, the current methodology does not appear to meet the test of fairness and reasonableness as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court. It may also to be noted that unlike for CVC and some other statutory functionaries where zone of consideration. has been defined in a limited manner in the Act, the eligibility for appointment as CIC/ICs has not been properly detailed in the Act. As per-Section 12 of the Act, any person who has eminence in public life with wide knowledge and experience in law, science and technology, social service, management, journalism, mass-media or administration and governance is eligible to be appointed as CIC/ICs. As it is not easy to define eminence, the process needs to be such that persons from such varied walks of life have a chance of being considered for selection as CIC/ICs. This may be done either by inviting applications and then putting them to scrutiny at the level of Department or by appointment of a search committee consisting of eminent persons from various fields which may after due search and deliberations recommend panel of names for consideration of the high powered committee.

8. In view of these weaknesses in the existing system, various alternatives were considered and a more transparent and reasonable process was proposed for consideration (**Flag 'X'**). It may also be noted that at present one PIL filed by Arvind Kejriwal, an RTI activist, is pending consideration of the Supreme Court on this very issue and we have yet to take a formal stand on that PIL.

9. In view of the above, it is felt that there is a need to revise our current methodology for selection of CIC/ICs. In this regard the draft proposal (Flag 'X') may be considered for framing of suitable guidelines for appointment of ICs.

1 .

Appointment of Information Commissioners in the Central Information Commission.

1. As per section 12 (2) of the Act, the Central Information Commission shall consist of the Chief Information Commissioner and such number of Central Information Commissioners, **not exceeding ten**, as may be deemed necessary. At present, the Central Information Commissioners has Chief Information Commissioner and 6 (Six) Information Commissioners.

2. Section 12 (3) of the Act stipulates that the Chief Information Commissioner and the Information Commissioners shall be appointed by the President on the recommendation of a Committee consisting of the following:-

- (i) the Prime Minister who shall be the Chairman of the Committee,
- (ii) the Leader of the Opposition in the Lok Sabha, and
- (iii) a Union Cabinet Minster to be nominated by the Prime Minister.

3. As per Section 12(5) of the RTI Act, 2005, the Chief Information Commissioner and Information Commissioners shall be persons of eminence in public life with wide knowledge and experience in "law, science and technology, social service, management, journalism, mass media or administration and governance."

4. Section 12(6) of the RTI Act, 2005 mandates that "The Chief Information commissioner or an Information Commissioner shall not be a Member of Parliament or Member of the Legislature of any State or Union territory, as the case may be, or hold any other office of profit or connected with any political party or carrying on any business or pursuing any profession.

5. A Writ Petition was filed by Shri Namit Sharma against Union of India challenging the constitutional validity of sub-Sections (5) and (6) of Section 12 of

the RTI Act. Hon'ble Supreme Court delivered its Judgement on 13.09.2012. The operative part of the judgement is enclosed as Annexure-I.

6. Union of India filed a Review Petition against the said judgement of the Supreme Court. The judgement in Review Petition is reserved. In the meanwhile, the Supreme Court passed an interim order dated 16.04.2013, staying two of its said directions. The stay order is enclosed as Annexure – II.

7. PMO has conveyed the approval of the Prime Minister for starting the selection process for appointment on one post of Chief Information Commissioner and four posts of Information Commissioners in the current round of selection based on the earlier approved process, keeping in view, inter-alia, the observation and directions of the Supreme Court. For the sake of emphasis, some of the directions of the Supreme court are mentioned below:

- a. We hold and declare that the expression 'knowledge and experience' appearing in these provisions would mean and include a basic degree in the respective field and the experience gained thereafter. Further, without any peradventure and veritably, we state that appointments of legally qualified, judicially trained and experienced persons would certainly manifest in more effective serving of the ends of justice as well as ensuring better administration of justice by the Commission.
- b. The appointment of the Information Commissioners at both levels should be made from amongst the persons empanelled by the DoPT in the case of Centre and the concerned Ministry in the case of a State. The panel has to be prepared upon due advertisement and on a rational basis as afore-recorded.
- c. The panel so prepared by the DoPT or the concerned Ministry ought to be placed before the High-powered Committee in terms of Section 12(3), for final recommendation to the President of India. Needless to repeat that the High Powered Committee at the Centre and the State levels is expected to adopt a fair and transparent method of recommending the names for appointment to the competent authority.

8. The Prime Minister has also accorded approval for continuation of Search Committee, as given below during the current round of selection for appointment of ICs in the CIC as constituted on the last round of selection process.

A copy of Cabinet Secretariat's communication no. 8-21/2011-CS (A) dated 21.09.2011 on constitution of Search Committee during last round of selection of Information Commissioners in Central Information Commission is at Annexure-III.

9. As per earlier process, a circular had been posted on the website of DOPT on 31.05.2013 seeking particulars of the interested persons for the post of Information Commissioners in the Central Information Commission. The last date of receipt of applications was 28/06/2013. An advertisement was also published in the 2 leading English newspapers (Times of India and The Hindu) and in one Hindi newspaper (Dainik Bhasker).

10. In response, a total of 422 applications for the post of ICs in CIC have been received by the last date i.e. 28.6.2013. As per Section 12(5) of the RTI Act, 2005, the Chief Information Commissioner and Information Commissioners shall be persons of eminence in public life with wide knowledge and experience in "law, science and technology, social service, management, journalism, mass media or administration and governance."

11. Accordingly, all these 422 applications have been broadly categorised into 7 categories of knowledge and experience, as mentioned above. Few

applications which do not fall within these 7 categories, have been mentioned in "others" category. The category-wise distribution of these applications is as under;-

However, for the sake of categorisation, only the main field of knowledge and experience have been mentioned, while the additional fields of knowledge and experience, if any, have not been indicated. Tabulated details on the basis of such categorisation is at **Annexure-IV**.

12. As per the earlier procedure, the Search Committee would empanel the names of suitable persons to the Selection Committee headed by the Prime Minister for selection of ICs in the CIC.

DIRECTIONS OF HON'BLE SUPREME COURT DATED 13/09/2012 IN NAMIT SHARMA CASE

The provisions of Sections 12(5) and 15(5) of the Act of 2005 are held 1. to be constitutionally valid, but with the rider that, to give it a meaningful and purposive interpretation, it is necessary for the Court to 'read into' these provisions some aspects without which these provisions are bound to offend the doctrine of equality. Thus, we hold and declare that the expression 'knowledge and experience' appearing in these provisions would mean and include a basic degree in the respective field and the experience gained thereafter. Further, without any peradventure and veritably, we state that appointments of legally qualified, judicially trained and experienced persons would certainly manifest in more effective serving of the ends of justice as well as ensuring better administration of justice by the Commission. It would render the adjudicatory process which involves critical legal questions and nuances of law, more adherent to justice and shall enhance the public confidence in the working of the Commission. This is the obvious interpretation of the language of these provisions and, in fact, is the essence thereof.

2. As opposed to declaring the provisions of Section 12(6) and 15(6) unconstitutional, we would prefer to read these provisions as having effect 'post-appointment'. In other words, cessation/termination of holding of office of profit, pursuing any profession or carrying any business is a condition precedent to the appointment of a person as Chief Information Commissioner or Information Commissioner at the Centre or State levels.

3. There is an absolute necessity for the legislature to reword or amend the provisions of Section 12(5), 12(6) and 15(5), 15(6) of the Act. We observe and hope that these provisions would be amended at the earliest by the legislature to avoid any ambiguity or impracticability and to make it in consonance with the constitutional mandates.

4. We also direct that the Central Government and/or the competent authority shall frame all practice and procedure related rules to make working of the Information Commissions effective and in consonance with the basic rule of law. Such rules should be framed with particular reference to Section 27 and 28 of the Act within a period of six months from today. 5. We are of the considered view that it is an unquestionable proposition of law that the Commission is a 'judicial tribunal' performing functions of 'judicial' as well as 'quasi judicial' nature and having the trappings of a Court. It is an important cog and is part of the court attached system of administration of justice, unlike a ministerial tribunal which is more influenced and controlled and performs functions akin to the machinery of administration. 1011

6. It will be just, fair and proper that the first appellate authority (i.e. the senior officers to be nominated in terms of Section 5 of the Act of 2005) preferably should be the persons possessing a degree in law or having adequate knowledge and experience in the field of law.

7. The Information Commissions at the respective levels shall henceforth work in Benches of two members each. One of them being a 'judicial member', while the other an 'expert member'. The judicial member should be a person possessing a degree in law, having a judicially trained mind and experience in performing judicial functions. A law officer or a lawyer may also be eligible provided he is a person who has practiced law at least for a period of twenty years as on the date of the advertisement. Such lawyer should also have experience in social work. We are of the considered view that the competent authority should prefer a person who is or has been a Judge of the High Court for appointment as Information Commissioners. Chief Information Commissioner at the Centre or State level shall only be a person who is or has been a Chief Justice of the High Court or a Judge of the Supreme Court of India. **(STAYED)**

8. The appointment of the judicial members to any of these posts shall be made 'in consultation' with the Chief Justice of India and Chief Justices of the High Courts of the respective States, as the case may be.**(STAYED)**

9. The appointment of the Information Commissioners at both levels should be made from amongst the persons empanelled by the DoPT in the case of Centre and the concerned Ministry in the case of a State. The panel has to be prepared upon due advertisement and on a rational basis as aforerecorded.

10. The panel so prepared by the DoPT or the concerned Ministry ought to be placed before the High-powered Committee in terms of Section 12(3), for final recommendation to the President of India. Needless to repeat that the High Powered Committee at the Centre and the State levels is expected to adopt a fair and transparent method of recommending the names for appointment to the competent authority.

11. The selection process should be commenced at least three months prior to the occurrence of vacancy.

12. This judgment shall have effect only prospectively.

This is an application for stay of the operation of the judgment dated 13th September, 2012 passed in Writ Petition (C) No. 210 of 2012 titled <u>Namit Sharma</u> Vs. <u>Union of India</u> reported as 2013 (1) SCC 745 during the pendency of the Review Petition (C) No. 2309 of 2012 titled <u>Union of India</u> Vs. <u>Namit Sharma</u>.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties and we are not inclined to stay the operation of the entire judgment in <u>Namit Sharma Vs. Union of India</u> but we direct that the following directions in sub-paras 108.8 and 108.9 quoted here-in-below shall remain stayed during the pendency of the Review Petition (C) No. 2309 of 2012.

> 108.8 The Information Commissions at the respective levels shall henceforth work in Benches of two members each. One of them being a 'judicial member', while the other an 'expert member'. The judicial member should be a person

possessing a degree in law, having a judicially trained mind and experience in performing judicial functions. Α law officer or a lawyer may also be eligible provided he is a person who has practiced law at least for a period of twenty years as on the date of the advertisement. We are considered view of the that the competent authority should prefer а person who is or has been a Judge of the High Court for appointment as Chief Information Commissioners. Information Commissioner at the Centre or State level shall only be a person who is or has been a Chief Justice of the High Court or a Judge of the Supreme Court of India.

108.9 The appointment of the judicial members to any of these posts shall be made 'in consultation' with the Chief Justice of India and Chief Justices of the High Courts of the respective States, as the case may be".

We further direct that wherever Chief Information Commissioner is of the opinion that intricate questions of law will have to be decided in a matter coming before the Information Commissioners, he will ensure that the matter is heard by a Bench of which at least one member has knowledge and experience in the field of Law.

We make it clear that subject to orders that may be finally passed after hearing the Review Petitions, the competent authority will continue to fill up the vacant posts of Information Commissioners in accordance with the Act and in accordance with the judgment in

W.P.(C) No. 210 of 2012 except sub-paras 108.8 and 108.9 which we have stayed. This is to ensure that functioning of the Information Commissioners in accordance with the Act and the Judgment is not affected during the pendency of the Review Petitions.

We further make it clear that the Chief Commissioners already functioning will continue to function until the disposal of the Review Petitions.

I.A.No. 6 is ordered accordingly.

Agenda Note

Appointment of Information Commissioners in the Central Information Commission.

1. As per section 12 (2) of the Act, the Central Information Commission shall consist of the Chief Information Commissioner and such number of Central Information Commissioners, **not exceeding ten**, as may be deemed necessary. At present, the Central Information Commission has Chief Information Commissioner and 6 (Six) Information Commissioners.

2. Section 12 (3) of the Act stipulates that the Chief Information Commissioner and the Information Commissioners shall be appointed by the President on the recommendation of a Committee consisting of the following:-

- (i) the Prime Minister who shall be the Chairman of the Committee,
- (ii) the Leader of the Opposition in the Lok Sabha, and
- (iii) a Union Cabinet Minster to be nominated by the Prime Minister.

3. As per Section 12(5) of the RTI Act, 2005, the Chief Information Commissioner and Information Commissioners shall be persons of eminence in public life with wide knowledge and experience in "law, science and technology, social service, management, journalism, mass media or administration and governance."

4. Section 12(6) of the RTI Act, 2005 mandates that "The Chief Information commissioner or an Information Commissioner shall not be a Member of Parliament or Member of the Legislature of any State or Union territory, as the case may be, or hold any other office of profit or connected with any political party or carrying on any business or pursuing any profession.

5. A Writ Petition was filed by Shri Namit Sharma against Union of India challenging the constitutional validity of sub-Sections (5) and (6) of Section 12 of

the RTI Act. Hon'ble Supreme Court delivered its Judgement on 13.09.2012. The operative part of the judgement is enclosed as Annexure-I.

6. Union of India filed a Review Petition against the said judgement of the Supreme Court. The judgement in Review Petition is reserved. In the meanwhile, the Supreme Court passed an interim order dated 16.04.2013, staying two of its said directions. The stay order is enclosed as Annexure – II.

7. PMO has conveyed the approval of the Prime Minister for starting the selection process for appointment on one post of Chief Information Commissioner and four posts of Information Commissioners in the current round of selection based on the earlier approved process, keeping in view, inter-alia, the observation and directions of the Supreme Court. For the sake of emphasis, some of the directions of the Supreme court are mentioned below:

- a. We hold and declare that the expression 'knowledge and experience' appearing in these provisions would mean and include a basic degree in the respective field and the experience gained thereafter. Further, without any peradventure and veritably, we state that appointments of legally qualified, judicially trained and experienced persons would certainly manifest in more effective serving of the ends of justice as well as ensuring better administration of justice by the Commission.
- b. The appointment of the Information Commissioners at both levels should be made from amongst the persons empanelled by the DoPT in the case of Centre and the concerned Ministry in the case of a State. The panel has to be prepared upon due advertisement and on a rational basis as afore-recorded.
- c. The panel so prepared by the DoPT or the concerned Ministry ought to be placed before the High-powered Committee in terms of Section 12(3), for final recommendation to the President of India. Needless to repeat that the High Powered Committee at the Centre and the State levels is expected to adopt a fair and transparent method of recommending the names for appointment to the competent authority.

8. The Prime Minister has also accorded approval for continuation of Search Committee, as given below during the current round of selection for appointment of ICs in the CIC as constituted on the last round of selection process.

9. As per earlier process, a circular had been posted on the website of DOPT on 31.05.2013 seeking particulars of the interested persons for the post of Information Commissioners in the Central Information Commission. The last date of receipt of applications was 28/06/2013. An advertisement was also published in the 2 leading English newspapers (Times of India and The Hindu) and in one Hindi newspaper (Dainik Bhasker).

10. In response, a total of 422 applications for the post of ICs in CIC have been received by the last date i.e. 28.6.2013. As per Section 12(5) of the RTI Act, 2005, the Chief Information Commissioner and Information Commissioners shall be persons of eminence in public life with wide knowledge and experience in "law, science and technology, social service, management, journalism, mass media or administration and governance."

11. Accordingly, all these 422 applications have been broadly categorised into 7 categories of knowledge and experience, as mentioned above. Few

applications which do not fall within these 7 categories, have been mentioned in "others" category. The category-wise distribution of these applications is as under;-
