Subject: Appointment of Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission.

PMO has conveyed the approval of the Prime Minister vide ID no. 600/5/C/4/2012-ES.2 dated 27/05/2013 for appointment of one post of Chief Information Commissioner and four posts of Information Commissioners in the current round of selection based on the earlier approved process, keeping in view, *inter alia*, the observation and directions of the Supreme Court.

2. A Writ Petition was filed by Shri Namit Sharma against Union of India challenging the constitutional validity of sub-Sections (5) and (6) of Section 12 of the RTI Act. Hon'ble Supreme Court delivered its Judgement on 13.09.2012. The operative part of the judgement is placed below.

3. Union of India filed a Review Petition against the said judgement of the Supreme Court. The judgement in Review Petition is reserved. In the meanwhile, the Supreme Court passed an interim order dated 16.04.2013, staying two of its said directions. The stay order is also placed below.

4. Appointment of Information Commissioners in the Central Information Commission is being dealt with separately. Regarding appointment of Chief Information Commissioner, the earlier practice had been that CIC is appointed from amongst the existing ICs. During the initial appointment of Chief Information Commissioner, the name of Shri Wajahat Habibullah was recommended by the Selection Committee for the position of Chief Information Commissioner. Regarding subsequent appointments of Chief Information Commissioners, both Shri A. N. Tiwari and Shri Satyanand Mishra were Information Commissioners, before their appointment as Chief Information Commissioner. Their names too were recommended by the Selection Committee for appointment as Chief Information Commissioner, as per the proceedings of the Committee. A copy of the said proceedings is placed below for perusal. Applications were never called for the post of Chief Information Commissioner in the past. It is also pertinent to mention that a resolution had been passed by the Information Commissioners of the Central information Commission in September, 2010 recommending that the successor of CIC should be from the existing ICs. A copy of the resolution is also placed below.

5. The existing Chief Information Commissioner viz. Shri Satyananda Mishra would retire on 4.9.2013. A list of existing Information Commissioners in the Central Information Commissioner is as under:-

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Subject:- Appointment of Chief Information Commissioner in the  
Central Information Commission.

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In exercise of the powers given by Section 12(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005, the Government has constituted the Central Information Commission. As per sub-section (2) of Section 12 of the Act, the Commission shall consist of one Chief Information Commissioner and upto 10 Central Information Commissioners. At present there is one Chief Information Commissioner and six Central Information Commissioners in the Commission. Shri Satyananda Mishra, present Chief Information Commissioner, is retiring on 04.09.2013. It has been decided to appoint a new Chief Information Commissioner in place of Shri Satyananda Mishra.

2. Section 13(1) provides that the Chief Information Commissioner shall hold office for a term of 5 years from the date on which he/she enters upon his/her office or till he/she attains the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier and shall not be eligible for re-appointment.

3. Section 12(3) of the Act stipulates that the Chief Information Commissioner shall be appointed by the President on the recommendation of a Committee consisting of the following:

- (i) the Prime Minister who shall be the Chairman of the Committee;
- (ii) the Leader of Opposition in the Lok Sabha; and
- (iii) the Union Cabinet Minister to be nominated by the Prime Minister.

4. Accordingly the Committee was constituted with the following composition to recommend the name of a suitable person for appointment as Chief Information Commissioner:

- (i) the Prime Minister
- (ii) the Leader of Opposition in the Lok Sabha, and
- (iii) the Minister for Law & Justice.

5. The Committee considered the proposal on 26<sup>th</sup> August, 2013 and recommended the name of Smt. Deepak Sandhu for

appointment as Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission.

6. Agenda note for the meeting and the proceedings of the meeting of the Committee are placed at Flag 'A' and 'B' respectively.

7. The Prime Minister may approve the recommendation made by the Selection Committee and may recommend to the Hon'ble President to approve the appointment of Smt. Deepak Sandhu as the Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission.





The Committee consisting of (i) The Prime Minister (ii) the Leader of Opposition in the Lok Sabha, and (iii) the Minister for Law and Justice under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Prime Minister met on 26<sup>th</sup> August, 2013 to consider the proposal for the appointment of the Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission and recommended the name of Smt. Deepak Sandhu for appointment as Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission. The file has been sent to Hon'ble President for his approval. The existing Chief Information Commissioner would retire on 4.9.2013.

2. MOS (PP) has advised that Oath of Office may be administered to the Chief Information Commissioner designate on the evening of 4.9.2013 itself.

3. The opinion of Ministry of Law as to whether the Oath of Office could be given to the new Chief Information Commissioner on the evening of 4<sup>th</sup> September, 2013 or it has to be on 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2013 or later was sought.

4. Ministry of Law and Justice has opined that normally, the Oath of Office should be administered to the new Chief Information Commissioner on the 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2013 or any time thereafter. However, if for any sufficient reason, it is proposed to administer the Oath to the new Chief Information Commissioner on the evening of 4<sup>th</sup> September, 2013, it will be advisable to add the words 'with effect from 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2013 in the Oath as under:-

"I,....., having been appointed Chief Information Commissioner with effect from 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2013 swear in the name of God/solemnly ....."

5. It is therefore proposed that the President Secretariat may be requested to seek the approval of Hon'ble President to administer Oath to the new Chief Information Commissioner on the evening of 4<sup>th</sup> September, 2013. Draft letter is placed below for approval.



Subject:- Appointment of Chief Information Commissioners in the Central Information Commission.

\*\*\*\*\*

In exercise of the powers given by Section 12(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005, the Government has constituted the Central Information Commission. As per sub-section (2) of Section 12 of the Act, the Commission shall consist of one Chief Information Commissioner and upto 10 Central Information Commissioners. At present there is one Chief Information Commissioner and nine Central Information Commissioners in the Commission. Smt. Deepak Sandhu, present Chief Information Commissioner, is retiring on 18.12.2013. It has been decided to appoint a new Chief Information Commissioner in place of Smt. Deepak Sandhu.

2. Section 13(1) provides that the Chief Information Commissioner shall hold office for a term of 5 years from the date on which he/she enters upon his/her office or till he/she attains the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier and shall not be eligible for re-appointment.

3. Section 12(3) of the Act stipulates that the Chief Information Commissioner shall be appointed by the President on the recommendation of a Committee consisting of the following:

- (i) the Prime Minister who shall be the Chairman of the Committee;
- (ii) the Leader of Opposition in the Lok Sabha; and
- (iii) the Union Cabinet Minister to be nominated by the Prime Minister.

4. Accordingly the Committee was constituted with the following composition to recommend the name of a suitable person for appointment as Chief Information Commissioner:

- (i) the Prime Minister
- (ii) the Leader of Opposition in the Lok Sabha, and
- (iii) the Minister for Law & Justice.

5. The Committee considered the proposal on 5<sup>th</sup> December, 2013 and recommended the name of Smt. Sushma Singh for appointment as Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission.

6. Agenda note for the meeting and the proceedings of the meeting of the Committee are placed at Flag 'A' and 'B' respectively.

7. The Prime Minister may approve the recommendation made by the Selection Committee and may recommend to the Hon'ble President to approve the appointment of Smt. Sushma Singh as the Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission.






