At present there is one Chief Information Commissioner and six Central Information Commissioners in the Commission.  - (iii) the Minister for Law & Justice.
- 5. The Committee considered the proposal on 26th August, 2013 and recommended the name of Smt. Deepak Sandhu for

appointment as Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission.

Subject:- Appointment of Chief Information Commissioners in the Central Information Commission.

In exercise of the powers given by Section 12(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005, the Government has constituted the Central Information Commission. As per sub-section (2) of Section 12 of the Act, the Commission shall consist of one Chief Information Commissioner and upto 10 Central Information Commissioners. At present there is one Chief Information Commissioner and nine Central Information Commissioners in the Commission. Smt. Deepak Sandhu, present Chief Information Commissioner, is retiring on 18.12.2013. It has been decided to appoint a new Chief Information Commissioner in place of Smt. Deepak Sandhu.

- 2. Section 13(1) provides that the Chief Information Commissioner shall hold office for a term of 5 years from the date on which he/she enters upon his/her office or till he/she attains the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier and shall not be eligible for re-appointment.
- 3. Section 12(3) of the Act stipulates that the Chief Information Commissioner shall be appointed by the President on the recommendation of a Committee consisting of the following:
 - (i) the Prime Minister who shall be the Chairman of the Committee;
 - (ii) the Leader of Opposition in the Lok Sabha; and
 - (iii) the Union Cabinet Minister to be nominated by the Prime Minister.
- 4. Accordingly the Committee was constituted with the following composition to recommend the name of a suitable person for appointment as Chief Information Commissioner:
 - (i) the Prime Minister
 - (ii) the Leader of Opposition in the Lok Sabha, and
 - (iii) the Minister for Law & Justice.

- 5. The Committee considered the proposal on 5th December, 2013 and recommended the name of Smt. Sushma Singh for appointment as Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission.
- 6. Agenda note for the meeting and the proceedings of the meeting of the Committee are placed at Flag 'A' and 'B' respectively.
- 7. The Prime Minister may approve the recommendation made by the Selection Committee and may recommend to the Hon'ble President to approve the appointment of Smt. Sushma Singh as the Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission.
