

IMPORTANT DEVELOPMENTS WITH REGARD TO DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL & TRAINING FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE, 2023

I. Summary of Selections and Appointments

- i. During the month of June 23, 10 (Ten) Selection Meetings [03 for CMD and 07 for Directors] were held by PESB, DoPT.
- ii. Appointments Committee of the Cabinet (ACC) approved appointments in 21 cases (i.e. MD/CEO/Functional Directors) in various Schedule A&B CPSEs. At present, there are a total of 52 posts of CMD/MD/Chairman and 85 posts of Functional Directors vacant in various schedule 'A' and 'B' CPSEs. Appointments of 32 Chairpersons/Members in various Tribunals / Statutory Bodies/ Authorities/ Commissions have been approved by ACC. Cabinet Secretary/ACC have approved the proposals for Extensions (08), Premature repatriations (03), Re-designation (02), Appointment as PS/OSD (03), Appointment to Foreign/ Captive post (12), Appointment to Foreign/Assignments (02). Further, proposal for extensions to Foreign/Captive Post (02) was also approved.
- iii. The Notification dated 08.06.2023 published in the Gazette of India regarding appointment of Shri BidyutBehari Swain as Member, Union Public Service Commission.
- iv. A total of 98 appointments by promotions to the IAS from the State Cadres of Rajasthan (16), Maharashtra (17), Madhya Pradesh (27), Assam (11) and West Bengal (27) were notified.
- v. Orders for fixation/re-fixation of seniority/ year of allotment of 31 officers appointed to IAS from State Civil Service of Assam (11), Madhya Pradesh (17), Odisha (01) and Nagaland (02) were issued.

Others

- i. Timelines for recording of PAR for the year 2022-23 in respect of AIS officers by the reporting/reviewing/accepting authorities have been extended by one month vide letter dated 15th June, 2023.
- ii. Guidelines on acceptance of awards from Government Bodies/Private Organizations by members of All India Services have been issued vide letter dated 22nd June, 2023.
- iii. A revised bond to be executed for availing Study Leave under Regulation 9 of IAS (Study Leave) Regulations, 1960, and guidelines on conduct during study leave have been issued vide letter dated 7th June, 2023.

iv. Presently, following posts are vacant under Central Staffing Scheme -

- 10 posts of Additional Secretary
- 36 posts of Joint Secretary and
- 60 posts at the level of DS/Director

II. Training and Capacity Building

(a) The Institute of Secretariat Training and Management (ISTM) conducted 03 Online Calendar Training Programmes, 11 CSS/CSSS Cadre Training Programmes and 01 DAKSHTA Programme during the month of June 2023. A total of 405 candidates participated in these Training Programmes.

(b) Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration (LBSNAA) conducted following programmes during the month of June, 2023:-

(i) The Mid-Career Training Programme for IAS officers of Phase-IV (8Th June to 2nd June, 2023). It was participated by 68 Officers.

(ii) The Mid-Career Training Programme for IAS officers of Phase-III (22nd June to 16th June, 2023). It was participated by 182 Officers.

(iii) Joint Civil Military Training Programme (31st June to 16th June, 2023). It was participated by 67 Officers.

(c) The Capacity Building Commission (CBC) has conducted the following activities:

- i. Capacity Building Commission organized first National Training Conclave at the International Exhibition and Convention Centre, Pragati Maidan, New Delhi on 11th June, 2023. The conclave was inaugurated by Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi. Hon'ble MoS (PP), Principal Secretary to the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Secretary, DoPT, Secretaries of Government of India along with others attended the event.
- ii. CBC organized a Workshop on 'Implementation of Annual Capacity Building Plan for Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) on 27.06.2023. The Workshop was chaired by Hon'ble Minister MoEFCC and Hon'ble MoS MOEFCC, Secretary, MOEFCC & attended by Ministry officials, Central and State Forest Training Institutions, Scientists and various domain experts.
- iii. CBC made a presentation on Annual Capacity Building Plan (ACBP) for Department of Social Justice & Empowerment during the month.
- iv. Capacity Building Commission organized a workshop on ChatGPT for Government of India officers hosted at the National Museum, New Delhi. During the workshop, officers delved into the intricacies of ChatGPT, exploring its capabilities in natural language processing, conversational AI, and practical day-to-day applications.

- v. Capacity Building Commission team under the leadership of Dr. R Balasubramaniam, Member HR visited the Meghalaya state. Government of Meghalaya and CBC are working closely to develop State Capacity at the District level for ensuring Citizen Centric Governance and in turn enhancing the ease of living for the citizens. MoU was also signed between the Government of Meghalaya and CBC to formally kickstart the process of Capacity Building in the state.

III. Establishment Matters

(i) Resolution No. 27(21)- EO/86(CC) dated 3rd March, 1987 has been amended vide Resolution No. 44011/2(s)/2022-Estt.(B-II) dated 20.06.2023 regarding mobility of managerial personnel among public sector enterprises.

(ii) Instructions regarding implementation of Aadhar Enable Biometric Attendance System (AEBAS) for attendance of all Government employees, by various Ministries/ Departments/Organizations were issued vide O.M. No. 11013/13/2023- Pers. Policy A-III dated 23.06.2023.

(iii) The Union Public Service Commission advertised 17 posts in 6 Min./Dept at the level of JS/Dir/DS in the month of June, 2023.

(iv) Staff Selection Commission (SSC) conducted following examinations during the month-

- a. The tier-II of Combined Higher Secondary Level Examination, 2022 was conducted on 26.06.2023 for 40,224 candidates in the Computer Based Mode.
- b. Multi Tasking (Non-technical) Staff and Havaladar (CBIC & CBN) Examination, 2022 in the Computer Based Mode on 20.06.2023. It was one of the largest examinations conducted by the Commission in 2023 having 54,28,630 registered candidates.
- c. The Phase-XI of Selection Posts Examination, 2023 along with Selection Post Examination for Ladakh (UT Administration) was conducted from 27.06.2023 to 30.06.2023 for 76,42,01 candidates.

(v) SSC declared result for the following examinations:-

- Final result of Lower Division Clerk Grade Limited Departmental Competitive Examination, 2017 on 20.06.2023
- Result of PET/PST on 30.06.2023 wherein 1,46,292 (1,31,848 Males and 14,444 Females) candidates were declared qualified for Detailed Medical Examination (ME) for the recruitment through Constable (GD) in Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs), SSF, Rifleman (GD) in Assam Rifles and Sepoy in Narcotics Control Bureau Examination, 2022.

(vi) Staff Selection Commission has published the Notice on its website on 30.06.2023 inviting applications for Multi-Tasking (Non-Technical) Staff, and Havaladar (CBIC & CBN) Examination, 2023.

IV. Vigilance and other related Matters

- (a) In respect of Central Bureau of Investigation- -
- i. Sanctions for Prosecution in 123 cases involving 461 persons were pending with various Ministries/Departments/State Governments for more than three months as on 31.05.2023.
 - ii. Out of 82 Public Grievances, 33 have been disposed of during the month and remaining 49 Public Grievances are being dealt appropriately.
- (b) Vigilance clearance of 33 IAS officers issued for various purposes viz. inter-cadre deputation, transfer, probation, ex-Indian-study leave etc.
- (c) Vigilance clearance of 12 IAS officers issued for Additional Secretary empanelment.
- (d) Vigilance clearance of 04 IAS officers issued for Joint Secretary empanelment.
- (e) 01 Privilege Notice received from Lok Sabha Secretariat and 01 Disposed off.

V. Rozgar Mela on June 13th, 2023 for “Mission Recruitment - 10 lakh recruitments in the Government”.

Rozgar Mela is a step towards fulfillment of the commitment of the Hon’ble Prime Minister to accord highest priority to employment generation in the country. Rozgar Mela is expected to act as a catalyst in further employment generation and provide meaningful opportunities to the Youth.

The 6th event of Rozgar Mela was held on 13th June, 2023 across the country in 43 locations. About 70,000 new appointees were inducted into various Ministries/Departments along with their attached and subordinate offices.

VI. Status of Follow-up Action on recommendations of Chintan Shivir of DOPT

- i. A Chintan Varta (talk) was organized on 08.06.2023 at CSOI Auditorium, Vinay Marg, New Delhi, in which the progress on the implementation of the recommendations of the Focus Groups (formed during Chintan Shivir on 17th – 18th February, 2023) was reviewed.
- ii. Shri Amarjeet Sinha, IAS, Member, PESB delivered a special talk on the subject: **“India’s Century, if....”**.
- iii. Five Officers of this Department who consumed maximum number of e-learning courses on i-GoT Karmayogi Platform were recognized.
- iv. “Redeployment and Surplus Management System (RSMS)” on online portal for management of staff declared surplus by various Ministries and its proper redeployment was launched by DOP&T during the Chintan Varta.

VII. Welfare Matters

CCSCSB organized summer coaching camp from 15th May 2023 to 14th June, 2023. Yoga, Cricket, Football, Basketball, Lawn Tennis, Volleyball and self Defence were organized for students of age group 8 to 16 years. More than 140 students participated in the summer camp.

IX. Promotions in CSS/CSSS Cadres

More than 2,500 promotions in various grades of Secretariat Services (CSS/CSSS) were made during the month. All promotions are now tech enabled on e-HRMS 2.0 portal and promotion orders are being issued on monthly basis.
