

**IMPORTANT DEVELOPMENTS WITH REGARD TO DEPARTMENT OF  
PERSONNEL & TRAINING FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE, 2024**

**I. Summary of Selections and Appointments:**

- i. Advertisements for 13 (Thirteen) posts [02 (Two) for the post of CMD/MD and 11 (Eleven) for the post of Directors] were issued by PESB, DoPT.
- ii. 07 (Seven) selection meetings [03 (Three) for CMD/MD and 04 (Four) meetings for Directors] were held.
- iii. 01 Post of Secretary and 09 posts of DS/Director have been filled under central Staffing Scheme. Presently, 16 posts of Additional Secretary, 38 posts of Joint Secretary and 60 posts at the level of DS/Director are lying vacant under Central Staffing Scheme.
- iv. Appointments Committee of the Cabinet (ACC) approved appointments in 10 cases (i.e. CMD/MD/CEO/Functional Directors/DMD/Director General/General Managers/Member) in various Schedule A & B CPSEs /PSBs/FIs/Railway Board.
- v. Appointments of 03 Chairpersons/Members in various Tribunals/Statutory Bodies/Authorities/Commissions and 02 appointments of Chief Executives/Directors in Autonomous Bodies/Institutes have been approved by ACC.

**II. Establishment Matters**

- (a) An OM dated 27.06.2024 was issued regarding Periodic Review of Central Government Employees for strengthening of administration under Fundamental Rule (FR) 56(j)(1) and rule 48 of CCS(Pension) Rules, 1972 [now, revised as Rule 42 of CCS(Pension) Rules, 2021].
- (b) An OM dated 15.06.2024 was issued regarding Instructions on implementation of Aadhar Enable Biometric Attendance System

(AEBAS) for attendance of all Government employees, by various Ministries/Departments/Organisations (MDOs).

- (c) Notification dated 31.05.2024 was issued regarding appointment of Shri Rakesh Ranjan, IAS (MN:92), as Chairman, Staff Selection Commission, with effect from the forenoon of 29.05.2024 in the rank and pay of Secretary to the Government of India by temporarily upgrading the post and keeping the Recruitment Rules for the post in abeyance.
- (d) A letter dated 21.06.2024 was issued regarding Extension of deputation tenure of Shri Rajiv Srivastava on the post of Member, SSC for a period of 03 months.
- (e) Notification dated 21.06.2024 was issued regarding implementation of Public Examinations (Prevention of Unfair means) Act, 2024
- (f) Notification dated 23.06.2024 was issued regarding The Public Examinations (Prevention of Unfair means) Rules, 2024.
- (g) Review of SSGSL of CSS officers (Director Grade) for the year 2018-2023 totalling 486 officers and one fresh inclusion in SSGSL-2017 has been done.
- (h) Preparation of panel for SSGSL-2024 and SGSL-2024 has been done.
- (i) Fresh inclusion of 07 CSS officers in SSGSL-2024 (Director Grade), 04 CSS officer in SGSL-2024 (DS Grade) in addition, and 01 fresh inclusion in SGSL-2023 has been done.
- (j) Staff Selection Commission (SSC) declared following results during the month-

  - iv. Additional result of Phase IX/2022 selection post examination for graduation and higher level, higher secondary level and matriculation level was declared on 21.06.2024 in which 1178, 27 & 811 candidates were declared successful under respective categories for further scrutiny.

### **IV. Training and Capacity Building**

#### **(a) Institute of Secretariat Training & Management (ISTM)**

- i. The Institute of Secretariat Training and Management (ISTM) conducted 10 Online/Offline Calendar Training Programmes, 03 Non-calendar course and 07 CSS/CSSS Cadre Training Programmes. A total of 988 candidates participated in various Training Programmes.
- ii. International Yoga Day 2024 was organized by ISTM on 21.06.2024.
- iii. Inauguration of ASO DR of remaining participants of 2023 batch started from 18<sup>th</sup> June, 2024.

#### **(b) Assistant Secretary Programme, 2024:**

The following activities were undertaken in June, 2024 in relation to Assistant Secretary Programme, 2024:

- i. The Assistant Secretaries called on the Hon'ble Vice President on 03.06.2024 at Vice President Enclave, New Delhi.
- ii. All the Assistant Secretaries visited Rajghat on 08.06.2024.
- iii. The Assistant Secretaries visited Pradhan Mantri Sanghralaya on 15.06.2024.
- iv. Hon'ble MoS (PP) had an interaction with the Assistant Secretaries on 27.06.2024 at CSOI Vinay Marg, New Delhi.

#### **(c) Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration (LBSNAA)**

The Mid-Career Training Programme for IAS officers of Phase-IV (18<sup>th</sup> June to 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2024) is undergoing. It has 83 Officers from batches 2000 to 2009 is participating.

**(d) Capacity Building Commission (CBC)**

**Workshop for Enhancing Leadership Communication for CPSE**

**Executives:** CBC hosted a 2-day unique workshop on "Enhancing Leadership Communication Skills of CPSE Executives" co-hosted with Department of Investment and Public Asset Management (DIPAM) in which more than 25 Panellist-Investors, Market Analysts and Communication Experts participated. In this workshop CPSE Executives made Real-world presentation simulation before the panel of experts and received immediate personalized feedback from Market and Communications Experts, besides strategies for enhancing their executive presence and audience engagement.

**Knowledge Partnership:** CBC signed a Knowledge Partnership with CEGIS on 18th June with an aim to provide access to larger training material and resources.

**Webinar in collaboration with Danish Patent Office (DKPTO):**

CBC organised a webinar in collaboration with Danish Patent Office (DKPTO) on 12th June on Patent Examination Processes within The Field of Pharmaceuticals, which had about 270 participants and another on 21st June on Patent Examination Processes within the Field of Medico, where about 350 people participated.

**Induction Program for Program Coordinators:**

CBC held a workshop with the Program Coordinators, onboarded through an open advertisement by CBC for coordinating and assisting the MDOs, in implementing the Capacity Building Plans and their Training Calendars and collecting data from MDOs (for training & non-training interventions) for monitoring and report purposes. The program Coordinators will also assist the MDOs in curation & consumption of the Domain Courses and sharing the analysis with the i-GoT content team.

#### (d) Karmayogi Bharat (SPV)

- i. Karmayogi Bharat has been recognized by NCVET as an Awarding Body (Dual Category), authorized to award, assess, and certify learners on the iGOT-Karmayogi Platform.
- ii. Karmayogi Bharat is actively facilitating the training of all Centre and State Police Departments on **Introductory Courses on newly enacted Criminal Laws**. As on 30th June, 2024 all three courses curated by Karmayogi Bharat on Three New Criminal Laws have marked 1,22,195 completions in June, 2024 and a cumulative of 5,90,954 completions on iGOT Karmayogi Platform.
- iii. The eService Book feature of eHRMS 2.0 is live for the Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT) and the President's Secretariat. This feature replaces the traditional paper-based service book with an electronic version, ensuring accuracy, accessibility, and transparency. The eService Book is designed to streamline administrative processes,

reduce paperwork, and enhance the efficiency of HR management across government departments.

- iv. Karmayogi Bharat held its first Chintan Shivir on 6th and 7th June, 2024 at LBSNAA, Mussoorie. The primary objective of the Shivir was to provide a platform for reflection, strategic discussions, and to outline the future direction for the iGOT Karmayogi platform, a key component of Mission Karmayogi.
- v. Karmayogi Bharat is constantly improving its user experience reinforcing anywhere any time learning through iGOT Karmayogi App that has achieved a rating of 4.5 on Android and iOS App store.
- vi. iGOT Karmayogi platform crossed **1.32 crore plus course enrolments** and 92.45 lakhs plus course completions till June, 2024.
- vii. iGOT Karmayogi platform hosts **39,18,795 on-boarded learners** as of June 2024. A total of 3,61,034 new users joined the Platform in June 2024.
- viii. The number of course completions in June 2024 was 8,78,243 and the total number of cumulative course completions till 30 June 2024 was **92,45,487**.
- ix. The number of active users logged in at-least once on iGOT platform in June, 2024 was 5.44 lakhs and the cumulative number of active users till 30 June, 2024 was 18.47 lakhs.
- x. iGOT Karmayogi portal recorded 6.8cr plus minutes of learning in June, 2024 and cumulatively reaching 79.3cr plus.
- xi. A total of thirty (30) new courses and one (1) curated program were added on the platform in June-2024.

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
