

IMPORTANT DEVELOPMENTS WITH REGARD TO DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL & TRAINING FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST, 2022

I. Training and Capacity Building

- i. The Capacity Building Commission(CBC) has conducted the following activities:
 - (a) Capacity Building Commission participated in the meeting at National Institute of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj (NIRDPR), Hyderabad on 5th August 2022 for preparation of the National Capacity Building Framework (2022) and Training of Panchayati Raj Institutions functionaries by NIRDPR.
 - (b) Capacity Building Commission held a kickoff meeting with the Mysore Municipal Corporation on 6th August, 2022 to develop an integrated approach for enhancing capacity at the Urban Local Body (ULB) level.
 - (c) Capacity Building Commission hosted a 'Brainstorming Workshop on Capacity Building Plan for Ministry of Environment, Forests & climate change on 12th August 2022. The workshop focused on building Integrated approach towards capacity building of forest services.
 - (d) Capacity Building Commission's Member (HR) Dr. R Balasubramaniam held interactions for institutional assessment with the faculty at Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development at Sriperumbudur, Chennai on 13th August, 2022.
 - (e) Capacity Building Commission's Secretary Shri Hemang Jani participated in a panel discussion at the Nanyang Technological University Singapore - India Dialogue on Technology, Innovation and Entrepreneurship. The seminar was on the Singapore-India Technopreneurship Partnership on 22nd August, 2022.
 - (f) Capacity Building Commission signed following MoU/SoI during the month of August 2022:
 - 1) Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) and Microsoft have entered an MoU with Capacity Building Commission on 3rd August, 2022 to enhance the digital productivity skills and functional computer literacy of the civil servants of Government of India.
 - 2) Statement of Intent (SoI) was signed on 16th August, 2022 between CBC & Development Monitoring and Evaluation Office (DMEO), NITI Aayog for Knowledge partnership. The SoI was signed for collaboration on various capacity building initiatives in data governance, monitoring and evaluation for the various Departments of Government of India.

- (iv) 04 Special interactive sessions were organized at CSOI, Vinay Marg for Assistant Secretaries.
- (v) The Institute of Secretariat Training and Management (ISTM) conducted 08 Organization Specific Programmes, 08 Calendar Training Programmes, 05 CSS Cadre Training Programmes, 01 CSSS Cadre Training Programme and 03 DAKSHTA Programmes during August 2022. A total of 843 candidates participated in these Training Programmes.
- (vi) Secretary (P) visited ISTM on 17.08.2022 and interacted with the participants of foundation training programme for ASO (DR).

- ii. PESA, DoPT issued advertisements for 12 (Twelve) posts of Director and 03 (Three) post of CMD. 02 (two) Selection Meeting was held for the post of CMD and 10 (ten) Selection Meetings were held for the post of Directors.
- iii. Two iterations of Service Allocation to the candidates of CSE-2021 have been done. 592 candidates have been allocated service on the basis of CSE-2021. During August, 2022 a total of 89 State Service officers were promoted to the IAS.
- iv. Appointment orders in respect of 16 Judicial Members of CAT were issued.
- v. Shri Suresh N. Patel, former MD&CEO, Andhra Bank, following his appointment as Central Vigilance Commissioner (CVC), has assumed the charge of his office on 03.08.2022, for a term of 04 years from the date of assumption of charge of office or till attaining the age of sixty five years, whichever is earlier.
- vi. Shri Praveen Kumar Srivastava, IAS (Retd.) (AM:1988) and Shri Arvinda Kumar, IPS (Retd.) (AM:1984) following their appointment as Vigilance Commissioners (VC) in the Central Vigilance Commission, assumed the charge of thier office on 03.08.2022, for a term of 04 years from the date of assuming of charge of office or till attaining the age of sixty five years, whichever is earlier.
- vii. 25 officers of Central Secretariat Service (CSS) were included in Selection Grade Select List 2022.

III. Special Campaign

In August 2022, 623 Public Grievances were redressed, out of 1171 Public Grievances including a backlog of 708. As part of Record Management, 279 files were reviewed and 110 files were weeded out and 08 Inter-Ministerial Cabinet References were disposed of.
