

## **IMPORTANT DEVELOPMENTS WITH REGARD TO DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL & TRAINING FOR THE MONTH OF DECEMBER, 2022**

### **I. Celebration of Good Governance Day on 25.12.2022:**

Hon'ble MoS (PP), Dr. Jitendra Singh launched the following to mark **Good Governance Day**:

- a) Revamped Probity Portal;
- b) e-HRMS 2.0 Portal for digital delivery of HR services to employees;
- c) Mobile Application of iGOT Karmayogi Portal for continuous capacity building;
- d) An e-Book compiling major Initiatives/Achievements of DOPT since 2014 and;
- e) Consolidation of Instructions (Master Circulars) on various subjects to promote ease of retrieval and comprehension.

### **II. Streamlining of Establishment related guidelines/ instructions:**

- i. Provisions regarding Strengthening of Administration by periodical review under FR 56(j): Statutory Body issued vide O.M. No. 261012/8/2022-Estt.A-IV dated 20.12.2022.
- ii. Instructions regarding Extension of the LTC block year 2018-21 (extended) for a period of three months has been issued vide O.M. No. 31011/24/2022-Estt.A-IV dated 27.12.2022.
- iii. The Union Public Service Commission (Members) Amendment Regulations, 2022 notified vide Gazette Notification No. 39019/22/2022-Estt(B) dated 30.12.2022 [G.S.R. 925(E)]

### **III. Summary of Selections and Appointments**

- i. Hon'ble President has authorized Shri Praveen Kumar Srivastava, Vigilance Commissioner, to act as the Central Vigilance Commissioner with effect from 25.12.2022 until the appointment of the new Central Vigilance Commissioner.
- ii. 6<sup>th</sup> iteration of Service Allocation to the candidates of the Civil Services Examination (CSE)-2021 have been done thereby allocating a total of 657 candidates to different services.
- iii. A total of 13 officers of State Civil Services from the States of Tamil Nadu, Jharkhand, Mizoram, Himachal Pradesh and Nagaland were appointed by promotion to the IAS.
- iv. Notifications for Change of Cadre in respect of two IAS officers were issued.
- v. Orders for fixation of seniority/ year of allotment to 21 officers appointed to IAS from State Civil Service/ Non-State Civil Services from Odisha (13), Tripura (02), Haryana-NSCS (04) and Nagaland (02) issued.

- vi. Appointment process to fill up not exceeding six posts of Information Commissioners in Central Information Commission has been initiated vide an Advertisement No. 4/5//2021-IR.II dated 20.12.2022.
- vii. Final Inter-se-seniority of direct recruit Assistant Section Officer's of recruitment year 2013 has been issued vide O.M. No. 7/1/2018-CS.I(A) dated 09.12.2022.
- viii. Final part Common Seniority List for the year 2013 has been issued vide O.M. No. 7/1/2018-CS.I(A) dated 01.12.2022.
- ix. Offer of appointment to 146 ASOs of 2020 batch has been issued and they are further nominated for Foundation Training Programme at Institute of Secretariat Training and Management, New Delhi w.e.f. 23.01.2023..
- x. PESB, DoPT issued advertisements for 04 (Four) posts of Directors and 04 (Four) posts of CMD/ MD/ Chairman. 02 (Two) Selection Meetings were held for the post of CMD and 09 (Nine) Selection Meetings were held for the post of Directors.
- xi. Appointments Committee of the Cabinet (ACC) approved appointments in 18 cases (18 Functional Directors) in various Schedule A & B Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs). Further, five (05) appointment of Chairpersons/Members in various Tribunals/ Statutory Bodies, three (03) appointments of Chief Executive in Autonomous Bodies/ Institutes, one (01) proposal of appointment to PS, five (05) proposals of appointment to Foreign Assignments, two (02) proposals of appointment to Non-CSS posts, one (01) proposal of extension, sixteen (16) proposals of Redesignation and one (01) proposals of Premature repatriations were approved by the Cabinet Secretary/ACC.
- xii. Staff Selection Commission has published its tentative examination Calender for the year 2023-24 on 30.12.2022 and also published the Notice inviting applications for Combined Higher Secondary (10+2) Level Examination, 2022 on 06.12.2022.
- xiii. During the month Staff Selection Commission (SSC) has conducted the following examinations:
  - a) Combined Graduate Level Examination (Tier-I) 2022 in the computer Based Mode w.e.f. 01.12.2022 to 13.12.2022.
  - b) Scientific Assistant in India Meteorological Department Examination, 2022 in the computer Based Mode from 14.12.2022 to 16.12.2022.

#### **IV. Training and Capacity Building**

- i. 18<sup>th</sup> round of Mid-Career Training Programme Phase-III is being organized from 19.12.2022 for IAS officers of 7-9 years of seniority at Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration, Mussoorie.
- ii. As on 30.12.2022, fourteen “Development of Attitude Knowledge & Skill for Holistic Transformation in Administration” (DAKSHTA) programmes for 320 participants of various Ministries & Departments have been organized by Institute of Secretariat Training and Management, DoPT.
- iii. The Capacity Building Commission(CBC) has conducted the following activities:
  - a) Cabinet Secretary chaired a workshop with Secretaries of all Ministries/Departments on creation of Annual Capacity Building Plans of each Ministry/Department, during a workshop organised by the Capacity Building Commission (CBC) at Vigyan Bhawan on 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2022. An Approach paper on Annual Capacity Building Plans prepared by CBC was also launched on the occasion. The event saw the presence of Secretaries of all Ministries and Departments and took the opportunity to brief them on the process of creation and implementation of Annual Capacity Building Plans. The Commission formally announced the scaling up of ACBP exercise across all 90+ central Ministries/Departments.
  - b) CBC participated in UAE Edition of the India Global Forum (IGF), ‘Partners for Global Impact’ supported by Embassy of India in the UAE, M/o External Affairs, held during 13<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> December, 2022 as ‘Eminent Speaker’.
  - c) Team of CBC participated in the ‘Chintan Shivir’ on ‘Self-Reliant Madhya Pradesh in Amritkaal’ organised by Govt. of Madhya Pradesh on 26<sup>th</sup> December, 2022.
  - d) Capacity Building Commission has signed tripartite MoU between Madhya Pradesh Government, i-GOT and CBC to support implementation of mission Karmayogi at State level.

## **V. Welfare Matters**

- a) Inter Ministry Power lifting, Weightlifting and Best Physique was organized at Netaji Nagar Gymkhana from 16<sup>th</sup> December to 20<sup>th</sup> December, 2022. A total of 185 government employees from different ministries participated in the event.
- b) Inter Ministry Volleyball was organized at Vinay Marg Sports Complex from 7<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> December 2022. A total of 18 teams from different ministries participated in the event.
- c) Inter Ministry Basketball was organized at Vinay Marg Sports Complex from 19<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> December, 2022. A total of 9 teams from different Ministries participated in the event.

## **VI. Vigilance Matters**

- a) Vigilance clearance of 14 (fourteen) IAS officers issued for various purposes viz. inter-cadre deputation, transfer, probation etc.

## **VII. Cyber Security**

- a. Cyber Jaagrukta Diwas was observed on 07.12.2022 and a webinar on “Forgery and Fraud using Mobile Devices” was organized by NIC for the employees of this Department.
- b. The existing network of DOPT has been segmented into NICNET and Internet by creating separate logical entities called Virtual LANs. The VLANs have been created division wise to ensure security of data and endpoints by NIC.
