

IMPORTANT DEVELOPMENTS WITH REGARD TO DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL & TRAINING FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY, 2022

I. All India Services Issues

- (i) Civil Services Examination (CSE) Rules, 2022 have been notified on 02.02.2022. An addendum has also been notified on 17.02.2022 for the inclusion of the Indian Railway Management Service (IRMS) in the participating services of CSE – 2022.
- (ii) A total of 10 appointments by promotion to the IAS were notified by the Central Government from the State Governments of Tamil Nadu (03), Odisha (03), Karnataka (01) and Manipur (03) respectively.
- (iii) Seniority/ year of allotment of a total of 20 officer's appointments by promotion to the IAS from the State Governments of Nagaland (05), Odisha (11), Uttar Pradesh (01) and Sikkim (03) respectively were determined and issued. Apart from this, notification for inter cadre transfer in respect of 4 IAS officers on ground of marriage was also issued.

II. Capacity Building

- (i) Hon'ble Minister of State, Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions inaugurated the "Innovations in Public Administration" program of Capacity Building Commission (CBC) on 04.02.2022 to identify successful innovations in public service pioneered by civil servants.
- (ii) The first meeting of the Board of Directors of Karmyogi Bharat, incorporated on 31.01.2022 under Section 8 of the Companies Act 2013 was held on 28.02.2022.
- (iii) Based on the competency requirement identified by CBC, ISTM conducted a six-day intensive Capacity Building Programme from 14-19 February 2022 in a blended mode for ASOs/SOs and Technical Officers of M/o Food Processing Industries (FPI).
- (iv) 5167 users and 142 live courses from 45 Ministries/ Departments have been migrated on the iGOT Karmayogi platform (beta version).
- (v) The first meeting of the Working Group on Capacity Building for the Infrastructure sector was held with the representatives from 14 Ministries / Departments / Organizations on 4th February, 2022.
- (vi) Capacity Building Commission organized two days virtual roundtable on Revisiting the History of Civil Service Reforms from Capacity Building Lens during 25th-26th February 2022 which was inaugurated by Hon'ble Minister of State, Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions.

III. Establishment Issues

(i) Instruction regarding grant of paid holiday to employees on the day of poll during General Election to the Legislative Assembly of State of Manipur-2022 and Bye-Election in 99 – Majuli (ST) AC of Assam Legislative Assembly, Punjab, Manipur, Uttarakhand & Uttar Pradesh, 2022 was issued vide OM. No. 12/1/2022-JCA dated 15.02.2022.

(ii) Instruction regarding attending office on regular basis by the Central Government employees was issued vide O.M. No. 11013/9/2014-Estt. A-III dated 06.02.2022.

(iii) Out of 3 candidates for appointment as Joint Secretaries, 19 candidates for Director and 9 candidates for Deputy Secretary through lateral recruitment, 30 candidates have since joined various Ministries/ Departments.

IV. Vigilance Clearances

Vigilance clearance in respect of 05 (five) IAS officers issued for JS empanelment and another 19 (nineteen) IAS officers for various purposes viz. Inter-cadre deputation, transfer, probation etc.

V. Special Campaign

During February-2022, 691 Public Grievances were disposed off and as part of Record Management, 790 files were reviewed and 04 Inter-Ministerial Cabinet References were disposed off.

VI. Selections and Appointments

(i) PESB, DoPT issued advertisements for 17 (seventeen) posts of Director/ Member and 02 (two) posts of MD/ CMD. Selection Meetings were held for 03 (three) posts of CMD/ MD and 12 (twelve) posts of Director.

(ii) Staff Selection Commission (SSC) published a Notice dated 01.02.2022 inviting applications for Combined Higher Secondary (10+2) Level Examination (CHSLE) – 2021 for Lower Divisional Clerk/ Junior Secretariat Assistant, Postal Assistant/ Sorting Assistant and Data Entry Operators for various Ministries/ Departments/ Offices of the Government of India and various Constitutional Bodies/ Statutory Bodies/ Tribunals, etc. Further, SSC has declared the following results:

(a) Junior Engineer (Civil, Mechanical, Electrical and Quantity Surveying & Contracts) Examination (Paper-II) -2020 on 25.02.2022.

(b) Skill Test (Typing Test) of Combined Higher Secondary (10+2) Level Examination - 2019 on 28.02.2022.

(iii) Staff Selection Commission also conducted the following examinations:

(a) Matriculation Level, Higher Secondary Level and Graduation & above level Selection post (Phase-IX) Examinations between 02.02.2022 and 11.02.2022 (except Punjab, Uttrakhand and UP).

VII. Welfare

(a) Inter Ministry Shooting Ball 2021-22 Tournament was organized from 22nd Feb to 24th Feb 2022 at Vinay Marg Sports complex. Seven teams participated in the tournament which includes more than 100 participants from different Ministries/Departments.

(b) Inter Ministry Badminton 2021-22 Tournament was organized from 27th - 30th December, 2021 and 21st - 28th Feb, 2022 at AIIMS Gymkhana. A total of 16 Men Teams and 8 women teams and 415 Men and 85 Women participated in the event. A total of 19 events were held.
