

## **IMPORTANT DEVELOPMENTS WITH REGARD TO DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL & TRAINING FOR THE MONTH OF JULY, 2022**

### **I. Training and Capacity Building**

- i. The Capacity Building Commission(CBC) has conducted the following activities:
  - (a) Dr. Jitendra Singh, Hon'ble MoS, Personnel, Public Grievances, Pensions Launched the 'National Standards for Civil Service Training Institutions' portal for accreditation and assessment for all civil service training institutions on 18<sup>th</sup> July 2022. This portal will help the Government of India to set common standards of excellence, promote organizational improvement through continuous self-assessment, enhance civil service capacity building with templates, institutionalize a forum to highlight best practices and collaborative learning, and give direction for long-term strategic planning.
  - (b) In collaboration with IFC - International Finance Corporation held a kickoff meeting with the Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation on 5<sup>th</sup> July 2022 to develop an integrated approach for enhancing capacity at the Urban Local Body (ULB) level.
  - (c) Held a meeting with the Ministry of Jal Shakti, the National Water Academy (NWA Pune, [nwapune.gov.in](http://nwapune.gov.in)), North-Eastern Regional Institute of Water and Land Management (NERIWALM Tezpur, [neriwalm.gov.in](http://neriwalm.gov.in)) and Rajiv Gandhi Ground Water Training & Research Institute (RGI Raipur, [ngwtri.org](http://ngwtri.org)) on 8<sup>th</sup> July 2022 for creating synergies in capacity building of the three training institutes.
  - (d) Held exploratory conversations with Nanyang Technological University Singapore for capacity building of science and technology Departments on 12<sup>th</sup> July 2022.
  - (e) Union Home Secretary Shri Ajay Bhalla launched Mission Karmayogi in Delhi Police Department on 13<sup>th</sup> July 2022 by training over 37,000 policemen who provide security and safety to Delhi's citizens. The behavioral and professional training is being facilitated by Capacity Building Commission through large-scale interventions.
  - (f) Participated at the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Conference of Indian Information Services (IIS) Officers held on 17<sup>th</sup> July 2022, and spoke about capacity building, citizen centricity, overcoming challenges in the information and broadcasting sector, and the future of communication technologies.
  - (g) Invited by the State Government of Assam to conduct a one-day workshop on 'Transformational Development Process through Institutional Reform'. The workshop was chaired by the Chief

Secretary of Assam and attended by all Secretaries, Commissioners and Department heads.

- (h) Facilitated the launch of Mission Karmayogi on 26<sup>th</sup> July 2022 in the Ministry of Roads and Transportation with the training of mid-level engineers from the National Highways Authority of India in collaboration with the Indian Institute of Technology, Bombay, and the Indian Academy of Highway Engineers (IAHE) in emerging technologies.
- (i) Member (HR), CBC held Meeting with Karnataka Government in the presence of the Chief Secretary on the Capacity Building of State Departments. Also, Member (HR), CBC held discussions and deliberations with DG Noronha for the Capacity Building interventions in the State of Madhya Pradesh.
- (ii) In reference to the Technical Assistance of World Bank to the tune of US \$47.0 Million in the form of a loan for the National Programme for Civil Services Capacity Building (NPCSCB) - Mission Karma Yogi, the Competent Authority in DEA i.e. Additional Secretary (MBC) has signed the loan agreement and other legal documents on 22.07.2022.
- (iii) The Institute of Secretariat Training and Management (ISTM) conducted 09 Organization Specific Programmes, 10 Calendar Training Programmes, 04 CSS Cadre Training Programmes, and 03 CSSS Cadre Training Programmes during July 2022. A total of 805 candidates participated in these Training Programmes.

## **II. Selections and Appointments**

- i. Appointment of Lt. General Raj Shukla, PVSM, YSM, SM (Retd.) as Member, Union Public Service Commission with effect from the forenoon of 18.07.2022, for six years or until he attains the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier, was notified vide Notification No. 39019/04/2020-Estt(B)(Pt.II) dated 22.07.2022.
- ii. PESB, DoPT issued advertisements for 03 (three) posts of Director and 01 (one) post of CMD. 01 (one) Selection Meeting was held for the post of CMD and 10 (ten) Selection Meetings were held for the post of Director/Member.
- iii. Shri Suresh N. Patel, former MD & CEO, Andhra Bank has been appointed as the Central Vigilance Commissioner in the Central Vigilance Commission, vide Warrant of Appointment dated 21.07.2022.
- iv. Shri Praveen Kumar Srivastava, IAS (AM:1988) and Shri Arvinda Kumar, IAS (AM:1984) have been appointed as Vigilance Commissioners in the Central Vigilance Commission.

- v. Consequent to the approval of the Appointments Committee of the Cabinet (ACC) communicated vide EO Division's letter No.6/15/2022-EP (SM.II) dated 30.06.2022, Shri Abhishek Singh, IAS (NL: 1995), CEO, NeGD has been entrusted with the additional charge of the post of Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Karma Yogi Bharat with effect from the date of assumption of charge, till the joining of the regular incumbent or until further orders, whichever is earlier.

### **III. Special Campaign**

In July 2022, 522 Public Grievances were redressed, out of 1220 Public Grievances including a backlog of 697. As part of Record Management, 370 files were reviewed and 166 files were weeded out and 05 Inter-Ministerial Cabinet References were disposed of.

### **IV. Vigilance Matters**

- a. Vigilance Clearance of 05 (five) IAS officers issued for JS empanelment.
- b. Vigilance Clearance of 30 (Thirty) IAS officers issued for various purposes viz. inter-cadre deputation, transfer, probation, etc.

### **V. Welfare Matters**

- a) Guidelines are issued regarding Covid Vaccination Amrit Mahotsav – free precaution dose to all the Central Government employees as a preventive measure to contain the spread of Novel Coronavirus vide O.M. No. 11013/9/2014-Estt. A-III dated 20.07.2022.
- b) Inter Ministry Swimming Tournament was organized at Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Swimming Pool, New Delhi on 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> July 2022. A total of 13 teams and 73 participants from different Ministries and Departments participated in the events.
- c) Two camps have been organized under a special drive “COVID vaccination Amrit Mahotsav” by the Government of India, for COVID Vaccination, on 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> July 2022 wherein 429 employees and their dependents were vaccinated.
