

## **IMPORTANT DEVELOPMENTS WITH REGARD TO DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL & TRAINING FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE, 2022**

### **I. Training and Capacity Building**

- i. Hon'ble CM Uttarakhand inaugurated AKAM digital exhibition and AKAM Seminar in LBSNAA. The events have been organized in collaboration with the Ministry of Culture. On this occasion, the LBSNAA is organizing an exhibition on "स्वतंत्रता संग्राम में ज़िलों की भूमिका" from 27<sup>th</sup> June to 3<sup>rd</sup> July, 2022.
- ii. The Joint Civil-Military program imbued with the principles of Mission Karmayogi was held in the LBSNAA from 8<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> June, 2022. The program was inaugurated by Hon'ble Raksha Mantri Shri Rajnath Singh.
- iii. Capacity Building Commission(CBC) has conducted the following activities:
  - (a) The launch of CBC-MyGov portal was held on 17<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 by Dr. Vinay Sahasrabuddhe, Hon'ble MP (RS) on 'Documenting Indian History of Public Administration' in association with Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan and in collaboration with Flame University in the presence of Shri Sanjay Kumar, Secretary, Youth Affairs and more than 400 District Youth Officers and State Directors of NYKS.
  - (b) The CBC team conducted the Capacity Building Need Assessment workshop at 4 centers of ISRO (Indian Space Research Organization)- Bangalore, Trivandrum, Ahmedabad and Sriharikota. The inputs from the workshop are currently being used for the drafting of the Annual Capacity Building Plan (ACBP) for the Ministry.
  - (c) The Annual Capacity Building Plan (ACBP) kickoff meeting was held with Secretary, Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES) and senior leadership to align on goals for capacity building in the department. A workshop with heads of all divisions of MoES was held to plan the Capacity Building Need Assessment exercise.
  - (d) An ACBP kickoff meeting and a workshop were organized with the Secretary, Department of Science & Technology (DST) and the DST team in Technology Bhawan.
  - (e) The final round of the 'Innovations in Public Administration' was organized by the Capacity Building Commission on 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2022 at the Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA), New Delhi. A total of 25 civil servants presented their innovations over the period of two days to two panels of judges.
  - (f) A five-day (June 20 - June 24) training programme was conducted in partnership with the Arun Jaitley National Institute of Financial

Management (AJNIFM), Faridabad for the Department of Economic Affairs on National Infrastructure Pipeline (NIP).

- (g) A workshop on "Enhancing Teaching Capacities of Central Training Institutes" was co-organized with the Sushma Swaraj Institute of Foreign Services. The workshop is the first step towards the institutionalization of structured, need-based and contextual Faculty Development Programs at Central Training Institutes (CTIs).
  - (h) Sensitization Workshop on Citizen-Centric Behaviour for State Administrative Services and Revenue Department Officers was conducted at RCVP Noronha Academy of Administration & Management, Bhopal.
  - (i) Kick-off meetings were held with Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation (AMC) and Rajkot Municipal Corporation (RMC) during the month.
- v. **A meeting was conducted on 8th June, 2022 under the Chairmanship of Secretary(P) with Chief Secretaries and Secretaries in charge (GAD/Training) of all States on the National Programme for Civil Services Capacity Building (NPCSCB) - Mission Karmayogi. It was suggested in the meeting to onboard the States also on the iGOTKarmayogi Platform so as to enable their officials /officers to take benefit from the Mission Karmayogi.**
- vi. **It has been decided that all government employees (working under Central Government as well as State Governments), with@nic.in or @gov.in email Ids, can register and onboard themselves on iGOTKarmayogi platform. Accordingly, all Chief Secretaries of States and Secretaries to the Govt. of India have advised to get their officers/officials onboarded onto the iGOTKarmayogi platform.**
- vii. During the National Conference of all Chief Secretaries of States organized by NITI Aayog on 15-17 June 2022, chaired by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, a session was organized on Mission Karmayogi, Where Secretary(P) and select Chief Secretaries participated.

## **II. Selections and Appointments**

- i. **Promotion of 8000+ CSS/CSSS/CSCS Officers:** Promotions were held up in the three services [Central Secretariat Service (CSS), Central Secretariat Stenographers Services (CSSS) and Central Secretariat Clerical Service (CSCS)] in all the grades, due to pending litigations in Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on the twin issues of "Reservation in Promotion" in SLP No.31288/2017 – Union of India and "Promotion of SC/ST on own merit" in SLP No.30621/2011 – Jarnail Singh &Ors. and similar such matters.

Based on the Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dated 28.01.2022 & Subsequent direction of Estt. (Res) dated 12.04.2022 promotion exercise was initiated and promotion orders of more than 8,000 officers in different grades of CSS/CSSS/CSCS were issued by 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2022.

- ii. PESB, DoPT issued advertisements for 07 (seven) posts of Director and 03 (three) posts of CMDs/MDs. 01 (one) Selection Meeting was held for the post of CMD and 13 (thirteen) Selection Meetings were held for the post of Director.
- iii. During the month Staff Selection Commission has issued the following:
  - a) Notice for inviting applications from eligible candidates for Stenographer Grade "C" Limited Departmental Competitive Exam 2017 was re-issued on 13.06.2022.
  - b) Revised Guidelines for evaluation of Typing Test/ DEST scripts were issued by the Commission on 22.06.2022.
  - c) Notice to conduct Statistical Investigator Gr. II Limited Departmental Competitive Examination, 2021 for promotion to the post of Statistical Investigator Gr. II in the office of Registrar General & census Commissioner, India (ORGI).

Further, the Combined Higher Secondary (10+2) Level (Tier-I) Examination, 2021 was completed successfully on 10.06.2022.

### **III. Service Matters**

- i. Cadre Review of IAS cadre of Karnataka, IPS Cadre of Jharkhand and Madhya Pradesh were notified in the Gazette of India Notification on 10.06.2022, 13.06.2022 and 24.06.2022 respectively.
- ii. Existing timelines for the recording of PAR for the year 2021-22 in respect of AIS officers by the reporting/ reviewing/ accepting authorities were extended in relaxation of Rule 5(1) read with Schedule 2 of AIS (PAR) Rules, 2007 by 15 days vide this Department's letter dated 15.06.2022.
- iii. Outstation posting in respect of 13 ASO were issued vide Order No. 7/9/2022-CS.I(A) dated 07.06.2022.
- iv. National Medical Commission was made a Sub-Cadre unit of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare vide Order No. 24/06/2021-CS.I(P)(Pt. I) dated 14.06.2022.
- v. 01-year service relaxation was granted to ASOs of the 2013 batch.

### **IV. Establishment Matters**

- i. Instructions were issued regarding the grant of paid holiday to employees on the day of poll, during Bye Election to 03 (three) Parliamentary Constituencies and 07 (seven) Assembly Constituencies of various States.

- ii. A list of holidays to be observed in the Central Government Offices during the year 2023 was issued.
- iii. A new sports discipline “Yogasana” has been added to the list of games for recruitment of meritorious sports persons to any post in Group C in Ministries/ Departments of Government of India vide this Department’s O.M. No. 14034/1/2013-Estt(D) dated 17.06.2022.

## **V. Special Campaign**

During June 2022, 352 Public Grievances were redressed, out of 1038 Public Grievances including a backlog of 454. As part of Record Management, 398 files were reviewed and 119 files were weeded out and 04 Inter-Ministerial Cabinet References were disposed of.

- d) All India Civil Services Table Tennis Tournament 2021-22 was organized in collaboration with Govt. of Uttar Pradesh from 24<sup>th</sup> June to 28<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 at Eklavya Sports Stadium, Agra, Uttar Pradesh.
- e) All India Civil Services Hockey Tournament 2021-22 was organized in collaboration with Govt. of Madhya Pradesh from 21<sup>st</sup> June to 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 at Major Dhyanchand Hockey Stadium Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh.
