

IMPORTANT DEVELOPMENTS WITH REGARD TO DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL & TRAINING FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH, 2022

I. Training and Capacity Building

- i. Hon'ble Prime Minister addressed the Valedictory Function of 96th Common Foundation Course comprising of 488 OTs from 16 Services and 3 Royal Bhutan Services (Administrative, Police and Forest) at Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration (LBSNAA) on 17.03.2022 via video conferencing. He also inaugurated the new sports complex and dedicated revamped Happy Valley Complex to the Nation and released 'Postal Pictorial Cancellation' of LBSNAA.
- ii. Cabinet Secretary inaugurated the IAS Professional course Phase-I (2021 batch) comprising of 183 Officer Trainees including 2 Royal Bhutan Civil Services on 21st March, 2022.
- iii. Induction Training of 30 candidates appointed at the level of Joint Secretary/ Director/ Deputy Secretary through lateral recruitment started in the Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA), New Delhi from 21.03.2022 and Hon'ble MoS(PP) addressed and interacted with them on 22.03.2022.
- iv. A Virtual Meeting of the officers of DoPT was held with the officers of Department of Economic Affairs (DEA) and the World Bank team on 04.03.2022 to negotiate the loan/technical assistance for the ongoing Public Service Capability Enhancement Project (PSCEP) [National Programme For Civil Services Capacity Building (NPCSCB) - Mission Karmayogi] and loan amount of USD 47 Million has been agreed.
- v. Learners' on-boarding process on the iGOT Karmayogi platform through eHRMS data integration continued during the month. A total of 6984 learners from 13 shortlisted MDOs have been on-boarded on the platform.
- vi. The Capacity Building Commission jointly organized a workshop for over 34 police official representatives of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel National Police Academy (SVPNPA) on "Becoming a Karmayogi Police person" during 28th - 31st March, 2022.
- vii. Capacity Building Commission undertook one week of Capacity Building Programme for Law Officers of Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) on 22nd March, 2022 at the Rastriya Raksha University, Gujarat.

II. Selections and Appointments

- i. Appointment of Shri Amarjeet Sinha, IAS (BH:83) (Retd.) as Member, PESB has been notified vide Notification dated 24.03.2022.
- ii. Shri Pradeep Singh Kharola, IAS (KN:85) (Retd.) was appointed as Chairman, National Recruitment Agency (NRA), New Delhi in the rank

and pay of Secretary to the Government of India on contract basis for a period of 03 years w.e.f. 23.03.2022 (FN) up to 22.03.2025 or until further order, whichever is earlier.

- iii. PESB, DoPT issued advertisements for 15 (fifteen) posts of Director/ Member and 05 (five) posts of MD/ CMD. Selection Meetings were held for 04 (four) posts of CMD/ MD and 15 (fifteen) posts of Director.

III. Lokpal Matters

A meeting of Delegated Investment Board (DIB) held on 25.03.2022 appraised and approved the proposal for acquisition of office space measuring 59,504 sq. ft. of super built area (44830 sq. ft. carpet area) comprising two floors (A-400 and A-500) at World Trade Centre, Nauroji Nagar, New Delhi at a cost of 254.88 crore through the e-Auction mode from the NBCC.

IV. Special Campaign

During March-2022, 793 Public Grievances were redressed, out of 1255 Public Grievances including backlog of 551. As part of Record Management, 3199 files were reviewed and 1976 files were weeded out and 07 Inter-Ministerial Cabinet References were disposed off.
