

IMPORTANT DEVELOPMENTS WITH REGARD TO DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL & TRAINING FOR THE MONTH OF MAY, 2017

1. Press Conference by MoS (PP) was held on 23.05.2017 at National Media Centre, New Delhi on three years initiatives of the Government. On this occasion, e-Booklet of DoPT was also launched by MoS (PP) which is available at web link <http://persmin.gov.in/ebook/index.html>.
2. 11th meeting of Hindi Salahkar Samiti was held under the chairmanship of MoS (PP) on 8th May, 2017.
3. Appointment's Committee of the Cabinet (ACC) has approved appointment of Nine (09) Chairpersons/Members in various Tribunals/ Statutory Bodies/ Authorities/ commissions, Five (05) Chief Executives in Autonomous Bodies/Institutes, One (01) proposals of Appointment of PS to Minister, Three (03) Premature repatriation and Six (06) Extensions.
4. Approval for conduct of LDC Grade Limited Departmental Competitive Examination-2017, Stenographer Grade-C Limited Departmental Competitive Examination-2017, Junior Hindi Translators, Junior Translators, Senior Translators, Hindi Pradhyapak Examination-2017 and Stenographer Grade-'C' & 'D' Examination-2017 by SSC in Computer Based Mode were conveyed vide letter No. 39020/04/2017-Estt(B) dated 16.05.2017.
5. Notification pertaining to the IPS Cadre of Chhattisgarh was notified on 19.05.2017.
6. Dr. Manoj Soni, has been appointed as Member, UPSC vide Order dated 19.05.2017.
7. Instructions regarding Procedure to be observed by the Departmental Promotion Committees (DPCs), Model Calendar for DPCs, Relevant year up to which APARs are to be considered and Model Calendar for conducting DPCs were issued vide O.M. No. 22011/4/2013-Estt(D) dated 08.05.2017. This will smoothen the process of holding DPC meetings on time.
8. Guidelines for revision of pay of the Chairpersons and Members of the Regulatory Authorities / Bodies consequent to the implementation of the 7th Central Pay Commission recommendations were issued vide this Department's O.M. No. 3/4/2016-Estt.(Pay-II) dated 30th May, 2017.
9. Instructions regarding fixation of pay of State Government Employees on their appointment in Central Government, subsequent to the implementation of CCS(RP)Rules, 2016 were issued vide this Department's O.M. No.12/2/2016-Estt.(Pay-I) dated 11th May, 2017.
10. Instructions on applicability of Central Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2016 to persons re-employed in Government Service after retirement and whose pay is debitale to Civil Estimates were issued vide this Department's O.M. No. 3/3/2016-Estt. (Pay II) dated 1st May, 2017.

11. A workshop on Sexual Harassment of Women at Work Place was held on 05.05.2017 at ISTM in collaboration with Ministry of Women & Child Development. The workshop was inaugurated by Smt. Maneka Sanjay Gandhi, Minister of Women & Child Development.
12. Central Civil Services Cultural & Sports Board organized Summer Coaching Camps in Football, Basketball, Cricket, Volleyball and self-defence for Children/ Dependents of Central Government Employees w.e.f. 15.05.2017.
13. Grih Kalyan Kendra (a welfare society working under the aegis of DOP&T) is completing 60 years this year. To celebrate its Diamond Jubilee, Grih Kalyan Kendra organized Blood donation camp, Free Health Check-up camp, Eye Check-up camp and Yoga Session on 28.05.2017 at Lodhi Road Complex Samaj Sadan, New Delhi for the benefits of Central Government Employees and their dependents.
14. The time limit for receipt of anomalies in the National Anomaly Committee was extended by three months from the date of expiry of receiving anomalies i.e. from 15.02.2017 to 15.05.2017 vide O.M. No. 11/2/2016-JCA dated 05.05.2017.
15. Instructions regarding amendment to Union Public Service Commission (Exemption from Consultation) Regulations, 1958 has been issued vide gazette notification dated 25.05.2017.
16. Total 26 training programmes were conducted at ISTM including 01 CSS-CTP and 02 CSSS-CTP programmes. The number of participants in these programmes was 711.
17. Yoga Training Session started for Government employees with effect from 24.05.2017 at North Block (Jalebi Chowk) during 5.30 P.M. to 6.30 P.M.
18. Blood Donation Camp was organised by DOP&T in association with the Indian Red Cross Society, New Delhi at Ministry of Defence, South Block, New Delhi on 19.05.2017 and 103 employees donated blood in this camp.
