

# **IMPORTANT DEVELOPMENTS WITH REGARD TO DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL & TRAINING FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 2021**

## **I. Administrative Tribunals**

The 19<sup>th</sup> Bench of Central Administrative Tribunal was inaugurated at Srinagar by Hon'ble MoS (PP) on 23.11.2021. The ceremony was attended among others by Chief Justice of J&K High Court and Chairman (CAT).

## **II. Training**

### **(i) Capacity Building Commission:**

#### **A. CBC's participation at Regional Conference**

Shri. Adil Zainulbhai, Chairman and Shri. Praveen Pardeshi and R. Balasubramaniam, Members, Capacity Building Commission attended the Regional Conference on 'Strengthening the State Institute of Public Administration' organised by DARPG on 11<sup>th</sup> November 2021 at Lucknow and chaired the following sessions –

- a. Transforming the Future-Public Solutions for improving Quality of life
- b. Faculty Capacity Building
- c. Mission Karmayogi & Future Vision of Training

#### **B. Workshop to develop citizen friendly Police forces**

A workshop to develop citizen friendly Police forces of Union Territories was organised at Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel National Police Academy (SVPNPA), Hyderabad on 19.11.2021. It was decided that nearly 10,000 police personnel in ranks of Inspectors, Police Sub Inspector (PSI), Assistant Sub Inspector (ASI) and Head Constables will be trained in customer orientation, problem solving, etc. to ensure positive police-citizen interaction.

#### **C. Roundtable for Annual Health of Civil Services Report (AHCSR)**

As part of exercise for preparation of Annual Health of Civil Services Report, a Roundtable was organized by CBC on 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2021 to obtain feedback on the First Chapter of the Annual Health of Civil Services Report (AHCSR) which encompasses CBC's current vision for what constitutes a healthy civil service at different levels of Government.

- (ii) A Working Group has been constituted to deliberate on GIS courses/module under Mission Karmayogi Scheme, vide O.M. No. T-16017/39/2021-iGOT dated 24.11.2021.

## **III. Selections and Appointments**

- (i) PESB, DoPT issued advertisements for 10 (ten) posts of Director and 01 (one) for CMD. 08 (eight) Selection Meetings were held for Directors of CPSEs.

(ii) Staff Selection Commission (SSC) has declared result of the following examinations:

- a) Paper-II of Junior Engineer (Civil, Mechanical, Electrical and Quantity Surveying & Contracts) Examination, 2019 on 23.11.2021.
- b) Tier-I of Combined Graduate Level Examination, 2020 on 26.11.2021.

#### **IV. Establishment Issues**

(i) Guidelines for simplification of processing of departmental proceedings under CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965 were issued vide O.M. No. 43020/14/2021-Estt. A-III dated 08.11.2021.

(ii) In view of increasing pollution an advisory regarding using public transport and sharing/ pooling of vehicles by Central Government employees posted in Central Government offices located in Delhi-NCR region while attending offices was issued, vide O.M. No. 11013/9/2014-Estt. A-III dated 16.11.2021.

(iii) Instructions regarding reimbursement of cancellation/ reschedule charges for Air/ Train tickets booked for the purpose of LTC and repayment of LTC advance due to Covid-19 pandemic were issued vide O.M. No. 31011/1/2020-Estt A-IV dated 23.11.2021.

(iv) Amendment to Union Public Service Commission (Exemption from Consultation) Regulations, 1958, regarding completion of one recruitment cycle to fill up ten posts of Deputy Superintendent of Police by deputation (including short term contract) in Delhi Special Police Establishment, Central Bureau of Investigation against vacancy circular of June, 2021, was notified vide Notification No. 39018/03/2021-Estt.(B) dated 24.11.2021.

(v) A notification regarding relinquishment of charge by Shri M.K. Gupta from the post of Member, PESB w.e.f. afternoon of 18.11.2021, was issued vide Notification No. 44011/10(s)/2018-Estt.(B-II) dated 24.11.2021.

#### **V. Vigilance Clearances**

Vigilance Clearance was issued for 25 IAS Officers for various purposes.

#### **VI. Welfare and Sports**

On the occasion of Azadi ka Amrit Mohatsav, DoPT has launched a drive – “संचय” from 29.11.2021 to 10.12.2021. Under the drive Government employees have been requested to donate clothes for distribution to under privileged people.

Following Inter Ministry Tournaments were organized in the month of November 2021:

- a) Inter Ministry Cricket Tournament is being organized from 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2021 to 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2021 at Vinay Marg Sports Complex and a total of 44 teams and more than 800 persons are participating in the event.
- b) Inter Ministry Football Tournament was organized from 20<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> November 2021 at Vinay Marg Sports Complex, and 18 teams participated in it.
- c) Inter Ministry Lawn Tennis Tournament was organized from 15<sup>th</sup> October to 1<sup>st</sup> November 2021 at Brassey Avenue Tennis Centre and 06 teams participated in it.
- d) Inter Ministry Hockey Tournament was organized from 15<sup>th</sup> November to 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2021 at Vinay Marg Sports Complex and a total of 12 teams including 2 Women Hockey teams (first time) participated in it.
- e) Inter Ministry Table Tennis Tournament is being organized from 29<sup>th</sup> November to 10<sup>th</sup> December 2021 at Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium and a total of 12 teams are participating in it.
- f) Inter Ministry Kabaddi Tournament was organized from 30<sup>th</sup> November to 1<sup>st</sup> December 2021 at Vinay Marg Sports Complex and a total of 4 Women teams and 9 Men teams participated in the event.
