

IMPORTANT DEVELOPMENTS WITH REGARD TO DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL & TRAINING FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER, 2021

I. Training

(i) The first Common Mid-Career Training Programme (MCTP) – “Leading to Learn” - LEAD Programme was organised in LBSNAA as part of Mission Karmayogi. This first Common MCTP was held for officers who have come through the Civil Service Examination of 1999 and 2000 (i.e. 2000 and 2001 batch officers). The programme was conducted at LBSNAA Main Campus on 26.10.2021 in which 248 officers participated. Inaugural address to the participants was delivered by Dr. Jitendra Singh, MoS(PP). The participants were also addressed by the Principal Secretary to PM and the Cabinet Secretary on the occasion of Rashtriya Ekta Diwas on 31.10.2021.

(ii) 27 (twenty seven) training programmes were conducted at the Institute of Secretariat Training and Management, attended by 1348 candidates.

(iii) Following activities were carried out by Capacity Building Commission (CBC) during the month:

(a) Central Training Institutions

The First Roundtable for Central Training Institutions (CTIs) was organised by Capacity Building Commission (CBC) on 12th October 2021 at the Indian Institute of Public Administration, Delhi which was attended by 44 participants comprising of top management of 23 CTIs to kickstart collaboration activities amongst CTIs, reinforce the importance of transition to an era of de-siloed learning and to discuss the proposed functional evaluation framework for CTIs. The event was graced by the presence of Hon'ble Minister of State (PP), Dr. Jitendra Singh and was presided by Dr. Hasmukh Adhia, Ex-Finance Secretary.

(b) Largescale Citizen-Centric Interventions – Department of Posts

CBC organised a focus group discussion with Gramin Dak Sewaks at Rafi Ahmed Kidwai National Postal Academy (RAKNPA) on 20.10.2021 to further its efforts towards developing and curating behavioural competencies needed to make Gramin Dak Sewaks more citizen centric, friendly and pro-service.

(c) UT Police Forces, Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA)

CBC in partnership with Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel National Police Academy (SVPNPA) has undertaken curation of a training course for trainers with focus on making interaction between citizens and police forces positive. The training at SVPNPA is scheduled for 10 - 21 Jan, 2022.

II. Special Campaign

During the Special Campaign launched by the Government for disposal of pending matters, 47 Implementation Reports (IRs) were finalized out of pending 56 Assurances. Similarly, 79 MPs References, out of 81 such references were disposed off. The Department also reviewed its old records, reviewing 33,000 files, out of which more than 21,000 old files have been weeded out. Old scrap has also been disposed off which freed a space of about 1500 sq. ft. Cleanliness drives were undertaken, especially of the corridors of North Block.

III. Selections and Appointments

(i) PESB, DoPT issued advertisements for 02 (two) posts of Directors. Selection Meetings were held for 01 (One) Managing Director and 10 (Ten) Directors of CPSEs.

(ii) Staff Selection Commission (SSC) conducted Skill tests for Stenographer Grade 'C' & 'D' Examination 2019 on 21st and 22nd October 2021. Further, the Commission has declared result of the following examinations:

- a) Final result of Junior Hindi Translator, Junior Translator and Senior Hindi Translator Examination, 2020 on 29.10.2021.
- b) Tier-I (Computer based examination) result of Combined Higher Secondary (10+2) Level Examination (CHSLE), 2020 On 26.10.2021.

(iii) SSC also published following important notices:

- a) Application for Junior Secretariat Assistant/ Lower Divisional Clerk Grade Limited Departmental Competitive Examination, 2018 issued vide notice dated 18.10.2021.

IV. Establishment Issues

(i) Common Seniority List for the grade of Assistant Section Officers was issued vide O.M. No. 7/9/2017-CS.I (A) dated 28.10.2021.

(ii) Order regarding bifurcation of the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation from the Ministry of Home affairs with respect to allocation of CSS/CSSS/CSCS posts was issued vide Order No. 21/10/2020-CS.I(P) dated 28.10.2021.

(iii) Instructions were issued regarding Grant of Paid Holiday during the conduct of Bye-election to 03 (three) Assembly Constituencies in various States.

V. Vigilance Clearances

Vigilance Clearance was issued for the following:

- a) 36 IAS Officers for empanelment at Secretary Level post.
- b) 20 IAS Officers for empanelment at Joint Secretary Level post.
- c) 90 IAS Officers for various purposes viz. Intercadre deputation, transfer, probation etc.

VI. Welfare and Sports

Following Inter Ministry Tournaments were organized in the month of October 2021:

- a) Inter Ministry Athletics Tournament was organized from 25th to 27th October, 2021 at Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium and 222 employees (including 48 women employees), from different Ministries/ Departments participated in it.
- b) Inter Ministry Chess Tournament was organized from 20th to 29th October 2021 at Grih Kelyan Kendra, Raja Bazaar, New Delhi and 11 teams participated in it.
- c) Inter Ministry Basketball Tournament was organized from 20th to 22nd October 2021 at Vinay Marg Sports Complex and 07 teams from different Ministries/ Departments participated in it.
- d) Inter Ministry Volleyball Tournament was organized from 27th to 29th October 2021 at Vinay Marg Sports Complex and 09 teams different Ministries/ Departments participated in it.
