

IMPORTANT DEVELOPMENTS WITH REGARD TO DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL & TRAINING FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER, 2022

I. Streamlining of Establishment processes:

- i. Instructions/ guidelines regarding recovery of wrongful/ excess payments made to the Government Servants, were issued vide O.M. No. 18/03/2015-Estt.(Pay-I) dated 03.10.2022.
- ii. Instructions/ guidelines regarding implementation of second penalty imposed during the currency of first penalty, were issued vide O.M. No. 11012/11/2018-Estt.A-III dated 28.10.2022.
- iii. Central Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Amendment Rules, 2022 were notified vide Gazette Notification dated 19.10.2022.
- iv. Instructions regarding Central Civil Services (LTC) Rules, 1988 - Relaxation to travel by air to visit North East Region, Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh and Andaman & Nicobar extension beyond 25.09.2022 has been issued vide OM No. 31011/15/2022--Estt.A-IV dated 11.10.2022.

II. Selections and Appointments

- i. Hon'ble Prime Minister launched the recruitment drive '**Rozgar Mela**' through Video conferencing on 22nd October, 2022, when, in the first tranche, 75226 candidates were issued appointment orders. Secretary, DoPT welcomed Hon'ble PM and MoS(PP) and Hon'ble MoS delivered a welcome address. Hon'ble PM virtually addressed the new appointees. The event was managed and coordinated by DoP&T. On this occasion a short film about the event was also shown.
- ii. The event was organized simultaneously in 50 locations throughout the country where dignitaries handed over appointment orders to some of the new appointees. The Ministries and Departments inform that 8214 candidates had received appointment order at the venues and additional 11860 candidates were present on the venues totaling participation of 20,074 newly appointed candidates. Appointment orders to rest of candidates were sent by email/post by the concerned Ministries/ Departments/ Organisations after the event. Preparations for the next tranche of release of appointment order are continuing.
- iii. As part of the above event, the Rozgar Mela was organized in Delhi by DoPT at Institute of Secretariat Training and Management, Old JNU Campus, New Delhi, which was graced by Hon'ble MoS (PP) - Dr. Jitendra Singh, Hon'ble MoS of External Affairs - Smt. Meenakshi Lekhi, Secretary (Personnel) and other officials. On this occasion appointment letters were distributed to 600 newly recruited officials belonging to 21 Ministries/ Departments/ Organizations.
- iv. 12 Directors of Central Secretariat Service have been appointed as JS (in-situ).

- v. 1964 vacancies have been intimated to SSC to fill up the post of ASOs in CSS through Combined Graduate Level Examination – 2022 and 2023 (982 each).
- vi. Draft rules of Section Officer Limited Departmental Competitive Examination 2018 were finalized.
- vii. PESB, DoPT issued advertisements for 07 (Seven) posts of Directors and 03 (Three) posts of CMD. 01 (One) Selection Meeting was held for the post of CMD and 09 (nine) Selection Meetings were held for the post of Directors.
- viii. Appointments Committee of the Cabinet (ACC) approved appointments in 14 cases (14 Functional Directors) in various Schedule A & B Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs). Further, three (03) appointment of Chairperson/Member in various Tribunals/ Statutory Bodies/ Authorities/ Commissions, two (02) appointments of Chief Executive in Autonomous Bodies/ Institutes, three (03) proposals of appointment to PS, two (02) proposals of appointment to Non-CSS posts, five (05) proposals of extensions and two (02) proposals of Premature repatriations were approved by the Cabinet Secretary/ACC. Also, proposals for appointment of ten (10) CVOs and Premature Repatriation of one (01) CVO were approved by the Cabinet Secretary/ACC.
- ix. During the month Staff Selection Commission has declared the following results:
 - a) Final result of Multi Tasking (Non Technical) Staff Exam, 2020.
 - b) Combined Graduate Level Examination (Tier-II) Exam, 2021.
 - c) Final result of Stenographer Grade 'C' & 'D' Examination, 2020.
 - d) Skill Test of Combined Higher Secondary (10+2) Level Examination, 2020.
 - e) Final result of Combined Graduate Level Examination, 2020.

III. Training and Capacity Building

- i. The Central Deputation of the IAS officers of 2020 batch who were posted as Assistant Secretaries in various Ministries/Departments came to an end on 7th October 2022. The Hon'ble Prime Minister addressed the young officers in the Valedictory session held on 6th October, 2022 at Sushma Swaraj Bhawan, New Delhi.
- ii. The Institute of Secretariat Training and Management (ISTM) conducted 14 Organization Specific Programmes, 08 Calendar Training Programmes, 04 CSS Cadre Training Programmes, 04 CSSS Cadre Training Programmes and 02 DAKSHTA Programmes during

October 2022. A total of 832 candidates participated in these Training Programmes.

- iii. The progress made under various tracks of the Mission Karmayogi during the month are as follows:
 - a) The Procurement and Financial Manual of Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV), Karmayogi Bharat has been approved in the last board meeting which was held on 16.10.2022.
 - b) 14 key functionalities have been implemented on iGOT Karmayogi Platform.
 - c) Outreach Workshop was conducted for Ministries/ Departments/ Organizations, Training Institutes and Content Providers.
 - d) A total of 165 courses out of the 286 live courses on iGOT Karmayogi Platform have been reviewed and Course-wise as well as Content Provider specific feedback was shared with the respective Content Providers to update the courses.
 - e) GST registration on the name of Karmayogi Bharat was done.
- iv. As on 30.10.2022 a total of 117 Ministries/ Departments/ Organizations were onboarded for the 286 Live Courses on iGOT Karmayogi Platform. This brings the total number of users on the platform to 149091.
- v. The Capacity Building Commission(CBC) has conducted the following activities:
 - a) CBC organized a learning session on Leadership for Ministry of Civil Aviation on 21st October 2022 and presented the Annual Capacity Building Plan at Ministry of Civil Affairs' Chintan shivir under the leadership of Shri Jyotiraditya Scindhia, Minister of Civil Aviation and MoS General VK Singh.
 - b) Capacity Building Commission's team visited the trainings underway in the districts of Udhampur and Kathua, Jammu during October 21-22, 2022.
 - c) The Physical course on 'Emerging Technologies' by Capacity Building Commission was launched by Hon'ble MoS, Shri Rajeev Chandrasekhar. The course is developed by CBC in partnership with Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA) and Wadhvani Institute of Technology and Policy and designed as an introduction on key emerging technologies for civil servants, wherein the online part of the course is already available on iGOT, followed by 2 days offline program at IIPA.
 - d) CBC conducted Common Mid-Career Training Programme under Mission Karmayogi for the year 2002 Batch Officers, from 26th to 31st October, 2022 at LBSNAA.

IV. Special Campaign

- a) In October 2022 during Special Campaign 2.0, 4117 Public Grievances were redressed, out of 6582 Public Grievances including a backlog of 4414. As part of Record Management, 66266 files were reviewed and 54587 files were weeded out and 03 Inter-Ministerial Cabinet References were disposed off.
- b) A Nukkad Natak on Swachhata was performed by the officials of DoPT at North Block and Institute of Secretariat Training and Management, New Delhi on 31.10.2022.

V. Vigilance Matters

- a) Vigilance clearance of 01 IAS officer issued for Secretary empanelment.
- b) Vigilance clearance of 07 IAS officers issued for Additional Secretary empanelment.
- c) Vigilance clearance of 14 IAS officers issued for various purposes viz. inter-cadre deputation, transfer, probation etc.

VI. Cyber Jaagrukta

Cyber Jaagrukta Diwas is observed on 06.10.2022 and a webinar on “Data Security and Secure System” has been organized by NIC for the employees of this Department.

VII. Welfare Matters

- a) Inter Ministry Chess tournament was organized at GKK, Raja Bazar from 12.10.2022 to 21.10.2022. A total of 24 Ministries with 140 Men and 15 Women participated in the event.
- b) Inter Ministry Music and Dance was organized at CSOI, Vinay Marg, from 17th to 20th October 2022. More than 200 participants participated in the event from 20 different Ministries.
- c) Inter Ministry Football was organized at Vinay Marg from 06th to 28th October, 2022. A total of 19 teams from different Ministries and Departments participated in the event.
