

**IMPORTANT DEVELOPMENTS WITH REGARD TO DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL
& TRAINING FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER, 2022**

I. Streamlining of Establishment processes:

- i.** Consolidated instructions on Risk Allowance were issued vide O.M. No. A-27018/02/2022-Estt(AL) dated 02.09.2022.
- ii.** Instructions regarding acceptance of fee by Central Government Employees were issued vide O.M. No. A-37013/01/2018-Estt.(AL) dated 08.09.2022.
- iii.** Consolidated instructions on Central Civil Services (Joining Time) Rules, 1979 issued on 12.09.2022.
- iv.** Instructions regarding grant of 60 days special Maternity Leave in case of death of a child soon after birth/ stillbirth were issued vide O.M. No. 13018/1/2021-Estt.(L) dated 02.09.2022.
- v.** Instructions regarding extension of Special concessions/ incentives to the Central Government employees working in Kashmir Valley in attached/ subordinate offices or PSUs falling under control of the Central Government for a further period of three years with effect from 01.08.2021 were issued vide O.M. No. A-24011/22/2022-Estt.(L) dated 12.09.2022.
- vi.** Central Civil Services (Leave) Rules, 1972 were updated on 19.09.2022.
- vii.** Instructions regarding revised eligibility service for promotion to be followed by all concerned Ministries/ Departments has been issued vide OM No.AB-14017/4/2021-Estt.(RR) dated 20.09.2022.
- viii.** The consolidated instructions on Non Functional Upgradation in respect of Organized Group A Services has been issued vide OM No. AB-14017/13/2022-Estt.(RR) dated 15.09.2022.
- ix.** Consolidated Information Document on 'Redressal of grievances filed by Government servant on service matters' has been uploaded on the website of DOPT on 23.09.2022.
- x.** Consolidated guidelines on 'official dealings between the Administration and Members of Parliament and State Legislatures-observance of proper procedure, issued vide DOPT OM No. 11013/14/2022-Estt.A-III dated 13.09.2022.

II. Selections and Appointments

- i. Third iteration of the Service Allocation of the candidate of Civil Services Examination (CSE) – 2021 has been done and a total of 593 candidates have been allocated to different Services.
- ii. A total of 05 appointments were made through promotion, to the IAS of Maharashtra Cadre vide notification dated 29.09.2022.
- iii. A total of 01 appointment by Selection was made to the IAS of Gujarat Cadre vide notification dated 15.09.2022.
- iv. An Annual Conference of Principal Secretaries (Personnel/ GAD) of all States/UT Governments was held under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble MoS (PP) on 28.09.2022 at CSOI, KG Marg, New Delhi to deliberate upon the recruitment, services, vigilance and training related issues of the IAS.
- v. During September 2022 month following cases were processed and got approved:
 - a) Inter Cadre Transfer – 02
 - b) Inter Cadre Deputation - 01
- vi. Orders for fixation of seniority of officers induction to IAS from SCS/ Non-SCS of AGMUT (Mizoram segment), Bihar and Gujarat cadres were issued containing 29 officers.
- vii. PESB, DoPT issued advertisements for 07 (Seven) posts of Directors and 01 (One) post of CMD. 04 (Four) Selection Meeting was held for the post of CMD/MD and 12 (twelve) Selection Meetings were held for the post of Directors.
- viii. On the basis of the results of SOs/Stenos (Gr.I/Gr.B) LDCE 2016 & 2017, 468 officers were promoted as Section Officers against Select Lists 2016 & 2017 vide O.M. dated 23.09.2022.
- ix. Staff Selection Commission has published Notice of Combined Graduate Level Examination, 2022 on 17.09.2022.

Further, Staff Selection Commission has declared the following results:

- a) Skill test in Stenographer Grade 'C' & 'D' Examination 2020 on 23.09.2022.
- b) Paper-II of Lower Division Clerk Grade Limited Departmental Competitive Examination (LDCE), 2017 on 27.09.2022.

III. Training and Capacity Building

- i. The IAS officers of 2020 batch who have been posted as Assistant Secretaries in various Ministries/ Departments under deputation, called

on the Hon'ble Vice President of India on 14th September, 2022 at 18.00 hrs at Vice President House, Maulana Azad Road, New Delhi.

- ii. Shri Parameswaran Iyer, CEO, NITI Aayog had an interactive session with the Assistant Secretaries on 16th September, 2022 at 3.00 PM at CSOI, Vinay Marg.
- iii. A Circular Resolution was passed by the SPV Board to confirm the appointment of the Chairman and other Director of Board as per the Order No. 6/22/2022-EO(SM II) dated 26.08.2022.
- iv. As an immediate requirement for operationalization of SPV preparation of Financial Management Manual and Procurement Manual were completed.
- v. The Capacity Building Commission(CBC) has conducted the following activities:
 - (a) The Karmayogi Abhipray survey for the Indian Economic Service Officers' as designed by the Capacity Building Commission, was launched on 13th September 2022 by the Chief Economic Advisor of India (Dr. V. Anantha Nageswaran).
 - (b) Under the Skill India Mission a Capacity Building Programme was held at Indian School of Business (ISB) from 19th – 23rd September, 2022 as part of the strategic tie-up between CBC, ISB Executive Education and Ministry of Skill Development to enhance the skills of Civil Servants.
 - (c) The online training for Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS) India volunteers developed in collaboration with United Nations Institute for Training and Research (UNITAR) and CBC was launched by Hon'ble Minister of Youth Affairs & Sports and Information & Broadcasting at New Delhi on 21st September, 2022.
 - (d) Capacity Building Commission, Office of Principal Scientific Adviser (PSA) to the GoI and Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) have engaged with the Centre for Technology, Innovation and Economic Research (CTIER) and Ahmedabad University to develop and deliver the 'Building Science Leaders in India' programme. The training program started with 2-day online classes (7th -8th September, 2022) followed by offline training from 27th – 30th September, 2022 in Bangalore. The Hon'ble Minister of State for Ministry of Science and Technology inaugurated the Physical Course on 'Building Science Leaders in India on 29th September, 2022.
 - (e) A Joint meeting of Capacity Building Commission and Ministry of Mines was chaired by Sh. Prahlad Joshi, Minister of Mines to initiate interventions for better coordination among training institutes of the Ministry.

IV. Special Campaign

In September 2022, 34141 Public Grievances were redressed, out of 38535 Public Grievances including a backlog of 3366. As part of Record Management, 256 files were reviewed and 105 files were weeded out and 05 Inter-Ministerial Cabinet References were disposed off.

V. Central Services Matters

- a) Amendment in the Central Secretariat Service Rules, 2009 was made vide Gazetted Notification dated 22.09.2022.

VI. Welfare Matters

- a) Half Marathon was organized by CCSCSB in collaboration with YHAI in JLN Stadium on 25th September, 2022. More than 1200 persons participated in the event. This was the 3rd Marathon organized by CCSCSB. The event included 5Km, 10Km and 21Km Marathon.
- b) Inter Ministry Carrom was organized at GKK, Raja Bazar from 30.08.2022 to 07.09.2022. A total of 15 teams from different Ministries and Departments participated in the event.
- c) Inter Ministry Table Tennis was organized at JLN stadium from 12.09.2022 to 23.09.2022. A total of 23 teams from different Ministries and Departments participated in the event.
