The present reference is from Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Department of Personnel & Training (DOPT) seeking our concurrence from legal and constitutional angle in the Draft Note for the Cabinet (F/A) containing a proposal to introduce the Right to Information (Amendment) Bill, 2019 (The Bill) (F/B) suggesting amendments to Sections 13, 16 and 27 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 ('the Act') relating to the salaries and other allowances and other terms of office and conditions of services of Chief Information Commissioner (CIC)/ Information Commissioners (ICs) in the Central Information Commission (CIC) and State Chief Information Commissioner (SCIC)/State Information Commissioners (SICs) in the State Information Commissions.

- 2. The Background of the proposal is provided in para 2 of the Note wherein the evolution of the Act with effect from 12.10.2005 is provided. The existing provision relating to the term of office of CIC and ICs in the CIC and SCIC and SICs in the State Information Commissions are also elaborated. It also stated that as per the present provisions of Section 13 of the Act the CIC is equivalent to the Chief Election Commissioner and ICs in the CIC are equivalent to the Election Commissioner. Similarly, as per the provisions of the Section 16 of the Act the SCIC and SICs of the State Information Commissions are equivalent to Election Commissioner and Chief Secretary of the State. It is also stated that a Cabinet Note proposing amendments to the Act was considered earlier with the approval of the Cabinet vide their letter dated 5.4.2018. However, the same would not be included in the list of the business and therefore was not taken for consideration by Rajya Sabha. It is therefore proposed to amend sections 13 (1), 13 (2), 13 (5), Sections 16 (1), 16 (2), 16 (5) and sections 27 of the Act.
- 3. Justification for the proposed amendments is provided in para 4 of the Note wherein it is stated that the proposed amendments will remove the anomaly between CIC, ICs in the CIC, SCIC and ICs in the State Information Commissions and other equivalent authorities like Chief Election Commissioner and Election Commissioners. It is also stated that as per the move by the Government to rationalize the service condition in various statutory organizations/commissions it is imperative to rationalize the service condition of the CIC and ICs.
- 4. The Note seeks approval of the Cabinet for introduction of the Right to Information (Amendment) Bill, 2019 for amending the Sections 13(1), 13(2), 13(5), sections 16(1), 16(2), 16(5) and Section 27 of the RTI Act, 2005 with such modifications or changes of drafting and consequential nature, if any, as may be considered necessary, in consultation with the Legislative Department.
- 5. In this connection it is relevant mention that upon a reference from DOPT the subject matter was examined in this Department earlier vide our Dy. No. 270255/LS/20017 and 300440/LS/2018 and concurred in the proposal made earlier (F/C).
- 6. In view of the above since the proposed amendments in the Act are to remove the anomaly between CIC, ICs in the CIC, SCIC and ICs in the State Information Commissions and other equivalent authorities like Chief Election Commissioner and Election Commissioners being a matter of policy and we have already concurred in the proposal earlier there appears to be no legal or Constitutional objection to the proposal contained in the Note. Hence we may concur in the Note.

Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions (Department of Personnel and Training) has forwarded a draft Note for the Cabinet seeking the approval of the Cabinet for amendment of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (22 of 2005) and for introducing a Bill, namely, the Right to Information (Amendment) Bill, 2019, in Parliament.

- 2. Presently, the term of office of, and the salaries and allowances payable to, and the other terms and conditions of service of the Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission are the same as that of the Chief Election Commissioner and the Information Commissioners are as that of an Election Commissioner which in turn are equal to that of a Judge of the Supreme Court of India. Similarly, the salaries and allowances of the State Chief Information Commissioner and the State Information Commissioners are equal to that of an Election Commissioner and the Chief Secretary to the State Government, respectively.
- 3. It may be recalled that the Cabinet, in its meeting held on 4th April, 2018 had earlier accorded its approval for amending sections 13 (5) and 16 (5) of the RTI Act so as to provide that the salaries, allowances and other terms and conditions of service of the Chief Information Commissioner and the Information Commissioners of the Central Information Commission and State Chief Information Commissioner and State Information Commissioners shall be such as may be prescribed by the Central Government by rules. Consequential changes were also proposed in section 27 relating to rule making powers of the Central Government.
- 4. The Cabinet, while approving the proposal of the administrative Ministry, directed that the term of office of the Chief Information Commissioner, Information Commissioners, State Chief Information Commissioner and State Information Commissioners be also prescribed by the Central Government. To give effect to the directions of the Cabinet, it is also proposed to amend sections 13 (1), 13 (2), 16 (1) and 16 (2), relating to their term of office.
- 5. The administrative Ministry has stated in the Draft Note that a notice of intention to move the Right to Information (Amendment) Bill, 2018 was given to the Rajya Sabha on 11th July, 2018. However, the Bill was not included in the list of Business and therefore was not taken up for consideration by the Rajya Sabha.
- 6. Now, the administrative Ministry has proposed to introduce a fresh Right to Information (Amendment) Bill, 2019 in Parliament. It is proposed to make the following amendments to the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as the said Act):-
- (i) to amend section 13 of the said Act, so as to provide that the term of office, and the salaries, allowances and other terms and conditions of service, of the Chief Information Commissioner and the Information Commissioners of the Central Information Commission shall be such as may be prescribed by rules made by the Central Government. It is further proposed to provide that the Chief Information Commissioner and the Information Commissioners appointed prior to the commencement of the proposed legislation shall continue to be governed by the existing provisions of the Act;
- (ii) to amend section 16 of the said Act, so as to provide that the term of office, and the salaries, allowances and other terms and conditions of service, of the State Chief Information Commissioner and the State Information Commissioners shall be such as may be prescribed by rules made by the Central Government. It is further proposed to provide that the State Chief Information Commissioner and the State Information Commissioners appointed prior to the commencement of the proposed legislation shall continue to be governed by the existing provisions of the Act; and

(iii) to make consequential amendments in section 27 relating to rule making powers of the Central Government.

- 7. On the basis of the proposal contained in the draft Note for the Cabinet and the discussions held with the officers of the administrative Ministry, a draft Bill, namely, the Right to Information (Amendment) Bill, 2019 has been prepared and a copy thereof is placed at Flag 'X' for being appended as Appendix III to the Note for the Cabinet. The administrative Ministry has confirmed that the draft so prepared meets with their intentions and requirements and is in accordance with their proposal contained in the draft Note for the Cabinet.
- 8. The Department of Legal Affairs has examined the proposal of the administrative Ministry *vide* their notes at Flag 'Y' dated 9th July, 2019 and has concurred in the proposal of the administrative Ministry contained in the Cabinet Note.

The matter under consideration on this file is amendment of section 13(1), 13(2), 13(5), sections 16(1), 16(2), 16(5) of RTI Act, 2005, relating to the salaries & allowances payable to and the terms & conditions of service of CIC/IC and State CIC/ICs respectively and also Section 27 of the RTI Act which empowers the appropriate Government to make Rules to implement provisions of RTI Act, 2005.

- 2. The approval of MOS(PP) for the amendment of the Section 13(5), Section 16(5) and Section 27 of the RTI Act as proposed was obtained on 04.03.2017.
- 3. File was referred to Legislative Department on 27th March, 2018 and DOLA 28th March, 2018, Ministry of Law & Justice alongwith the Draft Cabinet Note, Draft Notification for CIC (Salary and Allowances, Other Terms & Conditions) Rules, 2017 and the Draft RTI (Amendment) Bill, for further comments if any and vetting of the Notification and finalization of the Draft RTI (Amendment) Bill. They have concurred and finalised the RTI (Amendment) Bill, 2018.
- 4. Cabinet Note was sent for approval of Cabinet on 03.04.2018. Cabinet Secretariat had conveyed the approval of the Cabinet vide DO letter No 13/CM/2018 dated 5/4/2018. The Cabinet further directed that the term of office of Chief Information Commissioner, Information Commissioners, State Chief Information Commissioners and State Information Commissioners be as prescribed by the Central Government.
- 5. Legislative Department was requested to draft a Bill. Legislative Department drafted the Right to Information (Amendment) Bill, 2018. Notice of intention to move the Right to Information (Amendment) Bill, 2018 was given to Rajya Sabha on 5th April, 2018
- 6. The Bill was not included in the list of Business and therefore was not taken up for consideration by the Rajya Sabha.
- 7. Notice of intention to move the Right to Information (Amendment) Bill, 2018 was again given to Rajya Sabha on 11th July, 2018. However, the Bill was not included in the list of Business and therefore was not taken up for consideration by the Rajya Sabha.
- 8. The Right to Information (Amendment) Bill was earlier approved by Hon'ble Prime Minister on 03.04.2018. The Note for the Cabinet on

amendment of the Right to Information Act, 2005 which was approved by the Cabinet on 05.04.2018.

- 9. The Cabinet Note with the same proposal was earlier considered and approved by the Cabinet on 05.04.2018 vide Cabinet DO letter No 13/CM/2018 dated 5/4/2018. The Cabinet further directed that the term of office of Chief Information Commissioner, Information Commissioners, Chief Information Commissioners and State Commissioners be as prescribed by the Central Government. The directions of the Cabinet mentioned above were carried out in the Bill and the Bill was given to Rajya Sabha on 11th July 2018. However the Bill was not included in the list of Business and therefore was not taken up for consideration by the Rajya Sabha.
- 10. With regards to the directions of the Cabinet mentioned above it is proposed to amend the Section 13(1), 13(2), 13(5), sections 16(1), 16(2), 16(5) and section 27 of RTI Act, 2005. For this purpose the draft Cabinet Note was put up for consideration of the Cabinet. The comments of Deptt. of Finance, Legislative Department & Deptt. of Legal Affairs obtained during the submission of the earlier proposal for amending the Section 13(5), Section 16(5) and Section 27 of the RTI Act. Hence no fresh interministerial consultation has been undertaken now.
- 11. The Cabinet in its meeting on 10.07.2019 has considered Cabinet Note on Amendment of the Right to information Act, 2005. Cabinet Secretariat has been requested for authority letter in another part file under submission. In view of the above file is being forwarded to D/o Legal Affairs for further comments if any and vetting of the following documents:
