- (i) the Prime Minister who shall be the Chairman of the Committee,
- (ii) the Leader of the Opposition in the Lok Sabha, and
- (iii) a Union Cabinet Minister to be nominated by the Prime Minister.

The Act further explains that for the purpose of removal of doubts, it is hereby declared that where the Leader of the Opposition in the House of the People has not been recognized as such, the Leader of the single largest group in opposition of the Government in the House of the People shall be deemed to be the Leader of Opposition.

4. As per Section 12(5) of the RTI Act, The Chief Information Commissioner and Information Commissioners shall be persons of eminence in public life with wide knowledge and experience in law, science and technology, social service, management, journalism, mass media or administration and governance.

5. Section 12(6) of the RTI Act, 2005 mandates that "The Chief Information Commissioner or an Information Commissioner shall not be a Member of Parliament or Member of the Legislature of any State or Union territory, as the case may be, or hold any other office of profit or connected with any political party or carrying on any business or pursuing any profession."

6. At present, the Central Information Commission has a Chief Information Commissioner and six Information Commissioners. Incumbency Statement of Chief Information Commissioner and Information Commissioners is placed at Flag 'A'. The incumbent Chief Information Commissioner is going to complete his tenure on 26.08.2020.

(iii) The terms and conditions on which such appointments are to be made, be specifically stipulated in the advertisement and put on the website as well;

(iv) The Search Committee ought to make criteria for shortlisting the candidates so that it is ensured that shortlisting is done on the basis of objective and rational criteria;

(v) Information Commissioners are appointed from other streams/categories as well;

(vi) Vacancies be filled up in future without any delay by initiating the process for filling up the vacancies one or two months before.



This proposal is regarding filling up of the vacant post of Chief Information Commissioner (CIC) in the Central Information Commission as the previous incumbent Shri Bimal Julka demitted office upon completion of his tenure on 26.08.2020.

2. In exercise of the powers conferred by Section-12(1) of Right to Information Act, 2005, the Central Government has constituted the Central Information Commission. As per Section-12(2) of the Act, the Commission shall consist of the Chief Information Commissioner and such number of Central Information Commissioners not exceeding ten, as may be deemed necessary.

3. As per Section-12(5) of the RTI Act, 2005, the Chief Information Commissioner and Information Commissioners shall be persons of eminence in public life, with wide knowledge and experience in "law, science and technology, social service, management, journalism, mass media or administration and governance".

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4. According to Section-12(3) of the Act, the Chief Information Commissioner and the Information Commissioners shall be appointed by the President on the recommendation of the Committee consisting of:

- (i) The Prime Minister who shall be the Chairperson of the Committee;
- (ii) the Leader of the Opposition in the Lok Sabha ; and
- (iii) A Union Cabinet Minister to be nominated by the Prime Minister.

And where the Leader of opposition in the House of the People has not been recognised as such, the leader of the single largest group in opposition of the Government in the House of the People shall be deemed to be the Leader of Opposition.

5. As per Section 13(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005, the Chief Information Commissioner shall hold office for such term as may be prescribed by the Central Government and shall not be eligible for reappointment. Provided that no Chief Information Commissioner shall hold office after he has attained the age of 65 years. Further provided that where the Information Commissioner is appointed as the Chief Information

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Commissioner, his term of office shall not be more than 5 years in aggregate as the Information Commissioner and the Chief Information Commissioner.

6. As per Section 27 (1), "the appropriate Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, make rules to carry out the provisions of this Act. Accordingly, The Right to Information (Terms of Office, Salaries, Allowances and other Terms and Conditions of Service of Chief Information Commissioner, Information Commissioners in the Central Information Commission, State Chief Information Commissioner and State Information Commissioners in the State Information Commission, Rules, 2019 have been framed and published in the Gazette vide Notification dated 24th October, 2019.

7. As per these Rules, the Chief Information Commissioner shall hold office for a period of three years from the date on which he enters upon his office. The other terms and conditions of appointment have also been laid out in these Rules.

8. Anticipating that the post of CIC in the Central Information Commission was due to fall vacant w.e.f. 27.08.2020, due to completion of tenure of Shri Bimal Julka, a proposal to fill up the vacancy was initiated by Department of Personnel & Training. The approval of Hon'ble Prime Minister was obtained for initiating the process of selection for suitable persons for the post of CIC and for the constitution of Search Committee.

9. Accordingly, the Committee as per Section 12(3) of the RTI Act, 2005, was constituted with the Prime Minister as Chairperson; and Shri Amit Shah, Union Home Minister and Shri Adhir Ranjan Chowdhury, Leader of the single largest Party in Opposition of the Government in the Lok Sabha, as Members.

10. The Prime Minister had on 10.07.2020 approved the constitution of a Search Committee for the present round of selection process (page. 1/cor.) as given below:-

- i. Cabinet Secretary
- ii. Secretary (Personnel)
- iii. Secretary (I&B)
- iv. Secretary (DPIIT)
- v. Dr. Manoj Panda, RBI Chair Professor, Institute of Economic Growth, Delhi University)

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> 11. Vacancy circular dated 09.07.2020 was accordingly uploaded in both Hindi and English on the website of this Department. An advertisement was issued on 11.07.2020 through the Bureau of Outreach and Communication

(BoOC) in the leading newspapers inviting applications for appointment to the post of CIC. The last date for receipt of applications was 31.07.2020.

12. In response, a total number of 139 applications had been received by the last date for the post of CIC in the Central Information Commission. List of these 139 applications may please be seen at pages 5-38/cor.

13. The Search Committee met under the Chairmanship of Cabinet Secretary on 19.08.2020 and shortlisted two candidates for the post of CIC in the Central Information Commission. Minutes of the Search Committee are placed hereunder (pages 39-41/cor).

14. The Meeting of the Committee constituted under Section 12(3) of the Right to Information Act, was held at 5:00 PM on 24.10.2020 under the chairmanship of the Prime Minister. Agenda note of the meeting is also placed hereunder (pages 71-73/cor). The Committee perused the Agenda note, including the details of the applicants along with their profile. In addition to the candidates shortlisted by the Search Committee headed by Cabinet Secretary, the Committee considered all eligible applicants who had applied in response to advertisement for the post of Chief Information Commissioner issued on 09.07.2020.

15. After due consideration, the majority of the Committee recommended Shri Yashvardhan Kumar Sinha, currently Information Commissioner in Central Information Commission, for appointment as Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission, with Sh. Adhir Ranjan Chowdhury recording that he has submitted his dissent note (pages 77-82/cor.). The minutes of the meeting dated 24.10.2020 are also placed at pp. 74-76/cor.

16. The profile of Shri Yashvardhan Kumar Sinha, who is presently recommended for appointment as Chief Information Commissioner, is also placed at page 76/cor.

17. Shri Yashvardhan Kumar Sinha who is a sitting Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission will be eligible to be appointed as Chief Information Commissioner for a period up to 03.10.2023, the date on which he completes 65 years of age.

18. Further, the salaries and other conditions of service of Shri Yashvardhan Kumar Sinha as Chief Information Commissioner will be as per The Right to Information (Terms of Office, Salaries, Allowances and other Terms and Conditions of Service of Chief Information Commissioner, Information Commissioners in the Central Information Commission, State Chief Information Commissioner and State Information Commissioners in the State Information Commission) Rules, 2019. 19. On receipt of approval of the Hon'ble President of India, a letter of offer stating the terms of office and other conditions of service will be made to Shri Yashvardhan Kumar Sinha. A draft of the offer of appointment is at Flag 'X'.

20. On acceptance of the offer of appointment by Shri Yashvardhan Kumar Sinha, the convenience of the Hon'ble President of India will be sought for administering an oath or affirmation according to the form set out for the purpose in the first schedule as per Section 13 (3) of the Right to Information Act, 2005. Once the oath of affirmation is administered, the appointment will be notified in the Gazette of India as per draft at Flag 'Y'.

21. In view of the foregoing, the Prime Minister may like to recommend to the Hon'ble President of India, the following:-

(i) to appoint Shri Yashvardhan Kumar Sinha as Chief Information Commissioner in the Central Information Commission as per Section 12(3) of the Right to Information Act from the date he enters office for a period upto 03.10.2023.

(ii) The terms and conditions of appointment of the Chief Information Commissioner will be as contained in The Right to Information (Terms of Office, Salaries, Allowances and other Terms and Conditions of Service of Chief Information Commissioner, Information Commissioners in the Central Information Commission, State Chief Information Commissioner and State Information Commissioners in the State Information Commission) Rules, 2019.


