IMPORTANT DEVELOPMENTS WITH REGARD TO DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL & TRAINING FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 2023

I. Summary of Selections and Appointments

- i. Advertisements for 05 (Five) posts [01 (One) for the post of CMD and 04 (Four) for the post of Directors] were issued by PESB, DoPT.
- ii. 10 (Ten) selection meetings [04 (Four) for CMD/MD and 06 (Six) for Directors] were held by PESB, DoPT.
- iii. Appointments Committee of the Cabinet (ACC) approved appointments in 10 cases (i.e. CMD/CEO/Functional Directors) in various Schedule A & B CPSEs. At present, 35 posts of CMD/MD/Chairman/Members and 74 posts of Functional Directors are vacant in various schedule 'A' and 'B' CPSEs.
- iv. Appointments of 01 Chairperson/Member in various Tribunals/Statutory Bodies/Authorities/Commissions and 05 appointments of Chief Executives/Directors in Autonomous Bodies/Institutes have been approved by ACC.
- v. 16 Posts of Additional Secretary, 06 Posts of Joint secretary and 16 Posts of DS/Directors have been filled under central Staffing Scheme. Presently, 10 posts of Additional Secretary, 29 posts of Joint Secretary and 82 posts at the level of DS/Director are lying vacant under Central Staffing Scheme.

- (a) Amendment in IFS (Probation) Rules, 1968 was notified on 23.11.2023.
- **(b)** Indian Forest Service (Probationers Training and Evaluation) Rules, 2023 superseding IFS (Probationers' Final Examination) Regulation, 2026 were notified on 23.11.2023.

IV. Training and Capacity Building

(a) Institute of Secretariat Training & Management (ISTM)

- i. The Institute of Secretariat Training and Management (ISTM) conducted 05 Online Calendar Training Programmes, 02 Non-Calendar Training Programmes and 07 CSS/CSSS Cadre Training Programmes. A total of 426 candidates participated in these Training Programmes.
- ii. ASO DR-297, ASO DR-298 & ASO DR-299 Batch of ASO DR consisting of 175 officials were attached to Bharat Darshan & NGO exposure.
- iii. Blood Donation Camp and essay competition were organized by ISTM on 09.11.2023 for ASO DR 2022 batch.

iv. Secretary (Personnel) visited ISTM for an interaction with ASO DR 2022 Batch.

(b) Lal Bahadur Shashtri National Academy of Administration (LBSNAA)

- i. Letters issued to the Chief Secretaries of States regarding the nominations of participants for the upcoming Mid-Career Training Programmes IAS Phase-III, Phase-IV & Phase-V.
- ii. For the In-Service Training Programmes, similar letters have been written to the Chief Secretaries of all States and Cadre Controlling Authorities regarding nomination of eligible participants for the Induction Training Programmes for SCS officer promoted to IAS and Joint Civil Military Programme.

(c) Karmayogi Bharat

- i. More than **26 lakh users** have been on-boarded on to the portal (iGOT Karmayogi) so far. In the month of November, 1,43,349 new users joined the Platform.
- ii. The number of **active users** on the iGOT platform grew from 6.3 lakh in October'23 to 7.2 lakh in November'23.
- iii. iGOT portal recorded a cumulative **33.5 crore minutes of learning** as on 30th November 2023.
- iv. Number of **course completions** in November 2023 have risen to 5,14,273.
- v. Number of cumulative course completions till 30th November 2023 have risen to 34,04,474.
- vi. 40 new courses were published on the Platform in Novembe'2023.
- An **immersive workshop**, iGOT Manthan, was organised by Karmayogi Bharat on 9th November with 31 content providers, to assist them in gathering knowledge on the overarching goals of Mission Karmayogi, and their role in ensuring the creation of relevant and valuable content for the iGOT platform. Distinguished speakers at the workshop included Alakh Pandey, Founder, Physics Wallah; Smt Anita Karwal, Former Secretary, Department of School Education & Literacy; Shri K. Srinivas, Secretary, Ministry of Minority Affairs.

- Following the signing of the tripartite MOU between Government of Gujarat, Karmayogi Bharat SPV, and Capacity Building Commission (CBC), a one-day workshop on iGOT was conducted at Sardar Patel Institute of Public Administration (SPIPA, Ahmedabad) on 30th November 2023. 60+ participants from across State departments attended the session.
- ix. On the occasion of the first anniversary of **'Karmayogi Prarambh'**, Prarambh learners from various Ministries/Departments were invited on 22nd November to the Karmayogi Bharat office for a half-day interaction to share their experience and learnings from the *igotkarmayogi* platform.

(d) Capacity Building Commission (CBC)

Launch of Annual Capacity Building Plan (ACBPs):

CBC made the final presentation of ACBPs in respect of Rajya Sabha Secretariat as indicated below:

• A Presentation to the Additional Secretary of the Rajya Sabha secretariat on the ACBP work and process improvement plan for the secretariat was made on 7th November, 2023.

Training Program on Geospatial Technology and its applications conducted by ISRO:

Hon'ble MoS(PP) Dr. Jitender Singh inaugurated the training program on Geospatial Technology and its applications conducted by ISRO in Delhi and Shillong from 20th November to 25th November. ISRO Chairman and CBC Chairman also attended the program. More than 50 officers from 28 different MDOs participated. This is the first in line for a series of programs in Geospatial technologies. CBC has been working closely with ISRO to democratize learning in emerging technologies across the government.

Capacity Building Initiative:

As part of the Capacity Building of officials of the Ministry of Rural Development, the first batch of officials underwent training from 16th November - 17th November on **Emerging Technologies: Data-Driven Decision Making**. 23 officials from the department (from ASOs to the Director level) attended the program which was designed based on the needs of Department of Rural development so that data insights from various schemes of Department of Rural development about the Union and State Government can be used for impactful training.

District Capacity Building:

On 21st November, as part of the District Level Capacity Building Initiatives, the Capacity Building Commission team organised a workshop for the block officials of one of Meghalaya's Aspirational Block, Umling.

This workshop involved participants from across the departments and emphasised that achieving the vision of reducing multi-dimensional poverty is possible through collaboration and support among each other. The Meghalaya State Rural Livelihoods Society (MSRLS) and the Capacity Building Commission (CBC) jointly organised the workshop.

Onsite assessment and accreditation of Training Institute:

In the month of November 2023, CBC carried out assessments and accreditations of 14 Training Institutes.

Knowledge Partnership:

Capacity Building Commission signed MoU with the Gujarat State Government on 10th November in connection with the knowledge partnership.

- iv. **Constitution day** was celebrated on 26th Nov, 2023 at Vinay Marg Ground. The event was participated by more than 200 stundents of CCSCSB sports fraternity and officials.

VII. XIth tranche of Rozgar Mela on 30th November, 2023.

Rozgar Mela is an initiative towards fulfillment of the commitment of the Hon'ble Prime Minister to accord highest priority to employment generation in the country. Rozgar Mela is expected to act as a catalyst in further employment generation and provide meaningful opportunities to our Youth.

Hon'ble Prime Minister had launched the Rozgar Mela on 22nd October, 2022 and thereafter Rozgar Melas have been held almost regularly. The 11th tranche of National **Rozgar Mela** was held on **30th November, 2023** across the country at **37 locations**. The recruitments through Rozgar Mela are taking place across Central Government Departments as well as State Governments and Union Territories supporting this initiative. The new recruits, selected from across the country will be joining the Government in various Ministries/Departments and other Government organizations.
