ORDER

As per the provisions of the Clause (c) of Rule 2 of CSSS Rules, 2010, the length of "approved service" in respect of an officer recruited directly to a grade of the service is reckoned from the 'notional' date of 1st day of July of the year, following the year in which the examination for direct recruitment was held.

2. The Stenographers' Grade 'C' & 'D' examination, 2010 conducted in 2010 was cancelled due to administrative reasons and the examination was re-conducted in 2011. As a result the approved service of the incumbents recruited against the Stenographers' Grade 'C' & 'D' examination, 2010 has been counted from 1st July of 2012 causing undue hardship.

3. In order to obviate the undue hardship, this Department in consultation with UPSC has decided to relax the condition of the term 'approved service' in respect of Grade-D Stenographers of CSSS recruited through the Stenographers Grade 'C' & 'D' examination, 2010 to provide that the same would be reckoned from 1st July of 2011.

4. This order issues with the concurrence of UPSC in exercise of the powers conferred under Rule 23 of CSSS Rules, 2010 as a one-time relaxation vide their letter No.11/25(3)/2021-AP.1(STF) dated 16th June, 2022.
