**NOTIFICATION**

Reference is invited to the Notification of even number dated 01<sup>st</sup> August , 2<sup>nd</sup> August, 4<sup>th</sup> August , 18<sup>th</sup> August, 23<sup>rd</sup> August , 25<sup>th</sup> ,August, 29<sup>th</sup> August and 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2017 relating to the elections to Kendriya Bhandar.

2. Elections are required to be held in respect of Constituency No. 8, 16 and 18. The details of Polling Booths, the Names of Presiding Officer and Polling Officer / Pooling Assistant, the details of candidates etc. are attached at **Annexure**.

3. **The polling will be held on 6<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 in the respective Polling Booths. The polling should commence at 10.00 AM and shall continue, without any break up to 5.00 PM on 6<sup>th</sup> September, 2017.** However, minor variation of 30 minutes may be considered by the Presiding cum Assistant Returning Officer, if felt necessary, to suit the convenience of voters in a particular office. However, the total number of hours for casting votes should not be less than Six hours.

4. **Ballot Box will be opened and the counting of the votes shall be taken up on 7<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 at 11.00 AM in the presence of the candidates or their authorized agents.** However, before the seal on the box is broken, the Presiding Officer shall get a certificate signed by the candidates or their authorized agents to the effect that the seal was found intact before the ballot box was opened. Votes shall be counted either by the Presiding Officer or by the Polling Officer, in the presence of the Presiding Officer. Each candidate or his authorized agent shall have the right to be present at the time of counting. The number of votes secured by each candidate and the result of the elections should be announced by the Presiding Officer as soon as the counting is over on 7<sup>th</sup> September, 2017. In case of equal number of votes being secured by the candidates, the Presiding Officer shall decide the election result by tossing the coin. **The names of elected candidate(s) shall be intimated to the Returning Officer immediately and in any case latest by 6.00 PM on 7<sup>th</sup> September, 2017.** While conveying the result, the Presiding Officer shall obtain from the candidate and give full particulars of the elected delegate i.e. complete name, designation, office / department / branch in which he/she is working, telephone / mobile number and home address.
