

Important/Significant events in Department of Personnel & Training

Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month: August, 2019

1. Amendment in Central Civil Services (Conduct) Rules, 1964 regarding acceptance of gifts by Government servants was notified, vide O.M. No. 11013/02/2019-Estt.A-III, dated 06.08.2019.
 2. The RTI (Amendment) Act, 2019 received the assent of the President and was notified in the Gazette of India on 01.08.2019.
 3. 250 US and 211 SO were transferred under Rotational Transfer Policy - 2018.
 4. Staff Selection Commission (SSC) conducted Multi Tasking (Non Technical) Staff Examination (Paper-I) 2019 from 02.08.2019 to 22.08.2019. Also, the Commission has uploaded the result of Tier-I of the Combined Graduate Level Examination (CGLE), 2018, on 20.08.2019, on its website.
 5. Appointments Committee of the Cabinet (ACC) approved appointments in 13 cases (04 CMD/MD and 09 Functional Directors) in various Schedule A & B Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs). Further, eight (08) proposals of premature repatriations, ten (10) proposals of appointment of PS, ten (10) proposals of extension of tenures, five (05) proposals of Appointment of OSD and three (03) proposals of re-designation were approved by the Cabinet Secretary/ACC. Further, fourteen (14) officers were appointed as DCO (Director of Census Operation).
 6. PESB, DoPT issued advertisements for 10 (ten) posts [04(Four) posts of CMD/MD and 06 (six) posts of Director].
 7. Combined Foundation Course for Civil Services inductees has commenced from 26.08.2019 at LBSNAA, Mussoorie and MCR HRD Institute. 425 officers have joined the combined Foundation Course at LBSNAA, Mussoorie (325) including 11 from Royal Government of Bhutan and Dr. MCRHRD Institute (100).
 8. 19 training programmes were conducted in ISTM during the month of August. This included 02 CSS-CTP and 03 CSSS-CTP programmes. The number of participants in these programmes was 550.

 - c) Exemption from payment of examination fee & application fee in respect of Persons with Benchmark Disabilities, vide O.M. No. 36035/2/2017-Estt.(Res.), dated 23.08.2019.
