OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Continuance of promotion of Stenographer Grade 'D' of CSSS to the grade of Personal Assistant of CSSS on ad-hoc basis—Extension thereof—reg.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's O.M. No. 5/1/2020-CS II (C) dated 29.12.2020 vide which the promotion of Stenographer Grade 'D' of CSSS to the grade of Personal Assistant of CSSS on ad-hoc basis were issued by this Department.

2. As regular promotion of Personal Assistant of CSSS may take some more time, it has now been decided to extend the period of ad-hoc promotion to those, promoted vide O.M. mentioned in para-1 above, beyond 30.06.2021 to 31.12.2021 or till further order whichever is earlier on the existing terms and conditions and subject to following further conditions :-

- (i) The period of ad-hoc promotion would be upto 31.12.2021 or date of superannuation or date of their regular appointment or till further order in the grade whichever is earlier;
- (ii) The extension in the period of ad-hoc promotion shall be subject to **Vigilance Clearance** in terms of DoP&T OM No. 22034/4/2012-Estt.(D) dated 2.11.2012 and other relevant instructions on the subject;
- (iii) The ad-hoc appointment shall not confer on the appointees any right to continue in the grade indefinitely or for inclusion in the select list of Personal Assistant for regular appointment or to claim seniority in the Personal Assistant grade of CSSS;
- (iv) Ad-hoc appointment would continue till regular candidates in Personal Assistant grade are available either through Seniority quota or Limited Departmental Competitive Examination (LDCE). In the event of the ad-hoc appointees not qualifying for regular appointment in either of these two categories, they shall be reverted to the grade of Stenographer Grade 'D' on availability of such regular officers from the date the regular Personal Assistant join duty in their respective cadre units allotted to them by this Department;
- (v) The officer(s) who fail to avail ad-hoc promotion would not be considered for ad-hoc promotion for a period of one year from the date of issue of this promotion order;

3. The extension in ad-hoc promotion in para-1 shall subject to outcome on the following Court Cases:
- (i) The SLP (C) No.30621/2011 arising out of the final judgment and order dated 15.07.2011 in CWP No.13218/2009 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Punjab & Haryana and other connected cases before the Hon'ble Supreme Court;
 - (ii) The SLP (C) No.31288/2017 arising out of the Hon'ble Delhi High Court judgment dated 23.08.2017 in WP(C) No.3490/2010 filled by the All India Equality Forum & Others vs. UOI &Ors. and other related court cases in any competent court;
 - (iii) The SLP Dy. No. 35367/2019 in UOI & ANR Vs. Deepak Kumar & ORS pending before Hon'ble Supreme Court arising out of WP(C) No.1738/2017 with Hon'ble Delhi High Court judgment dated 01.07.2019, New Delhi;
 - (iv) Any other court cases in a connected matter.
